Many area residents will be competing in the popular Riverless Fun Run next Saturday, June 1 in Phillipsburg. Races for both adults and youths will begin at the First Christian Church, 150 S. 7th St. in Phillipsburg and will be sponsored by the Phillips County Hospital & Medical Clinics. Races will consist of a 2 Mile

Run/Walk, 5 Mile Run and One-Half Mile Kids Race (ages 4-10). Registration will be between 6:15 a.m. and 6:45 a.m. The 2-Mile Run/Walk will begin at 7 a.m. with the other races to follow.
