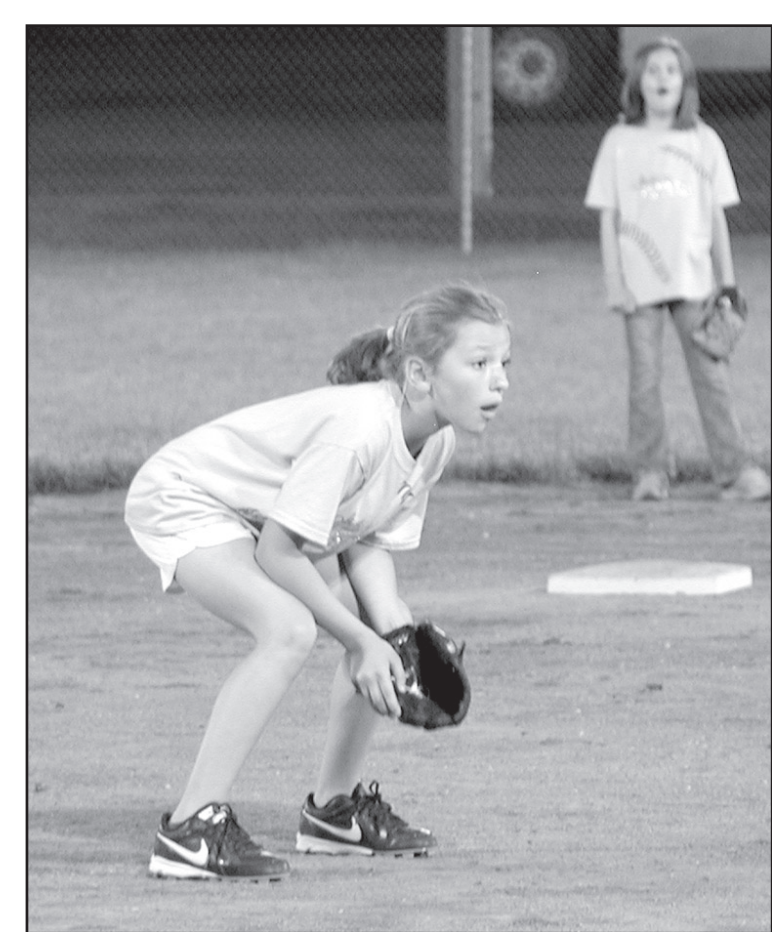


Summer ball season gets underway

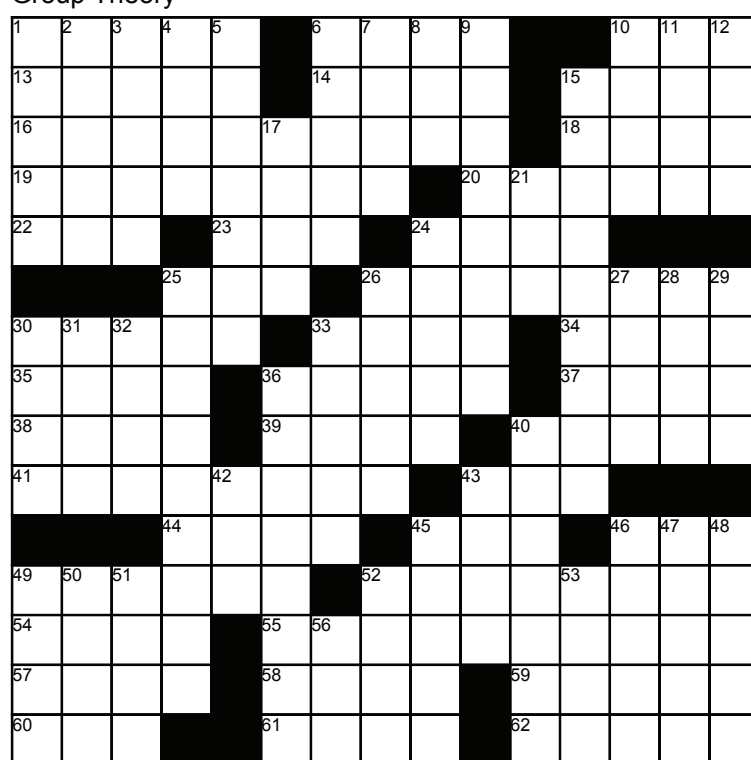
