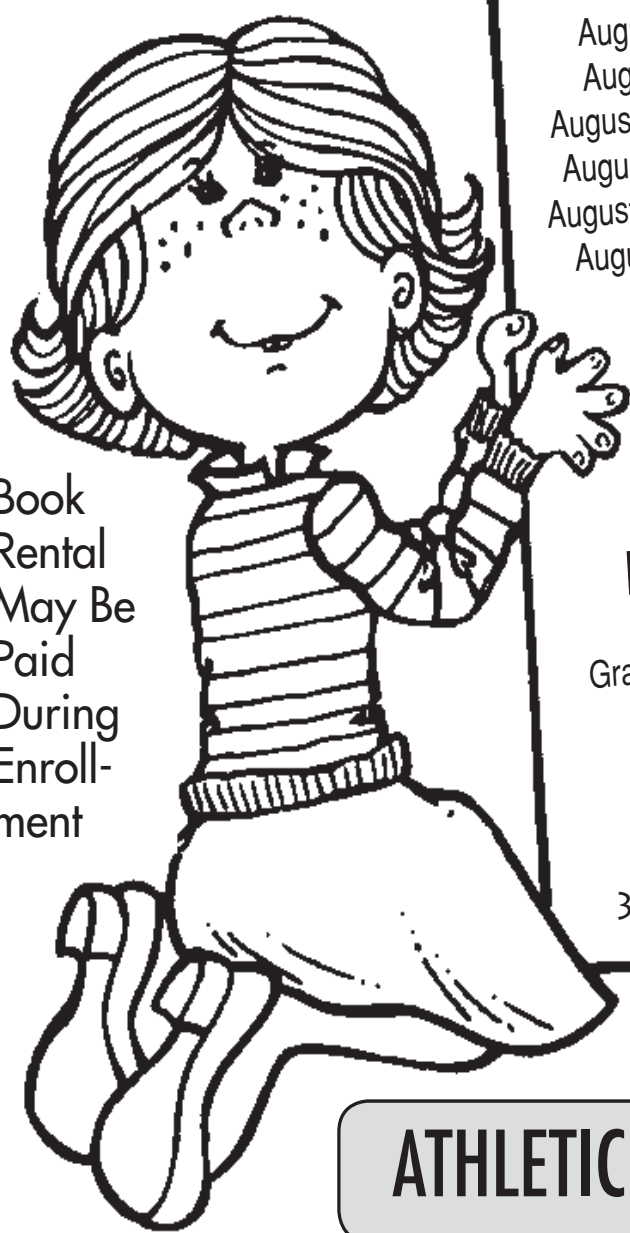

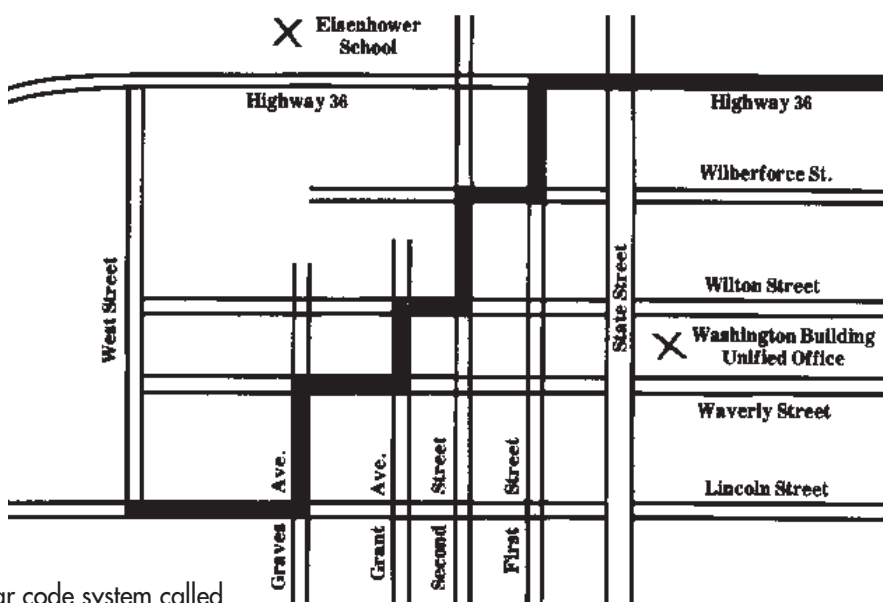

## ATHLETIC PRACTICES: All Fall Sports Practices Start on August 19

All elementary students will attend school at the Eisenhower building. However, any students living east and south of the marked line may go to the Washington building, where bus transportation will be provided to the Eisenhower school. Students should not arrive at Washington prior to 7:50 a.m. This shuttle leaves at 8:00 a.m. The same students will also be provided transportation back to the Washington building in the evening.



## Transportation:

**COUNTRY ROUTES:** Transportation Information Sheets are in the Parent Packets and available online. Please complete the Transportation Information Sheet and return it during school registration. Bus routes will be established after registration has been completed.

**EISENHOWER SHUTTLE:** USD #211 offers limited shuttle service for walking elementary students. The morning shuttle leaves from the Unified Office, 105 E. Waverly at 8:00 a.m. this is the only shuttle during the morning. Afternoon shuttle service will stop at the Unified office and there will also be a drop downtown at First Avenue and Main Street. Sign up for shuttle service will be held on registration day at the Eisenhower School. Buses will be assigned the first day of school.

**ACTIVITY TICKETS:** Activity tickets for the 2013-2014 session will be complimentary for Jr.-Sr. High students. Students must present their activity ticket at each school activity they attend. These activity tickets are not transferrable.

The district uses an electronic bar code system called Meal Tracker for lunch tickets. Elementary students are issued a permanent, laminated card. Initial cards are issued to each student at no cost. Cards which are lost, stolen, or defaced will cost two dollars to replace. However, any funds remaining in the account of the lost card will be transferred to the new account. Parents may purchase lunch credits in any amount.

When the amount of credit available in any account reaches a point equal to or less than two meals, a reminder is printed and given to the student.

The statement also prints the current account balance.
