Norton tennis team takes runner-up at **Hays Invitational**

nortontelegram@nwkansas.com Coach Jim Green's Norton Community High School varsity tennis team turned in a great performance on Thursday, finishing runner-up in the Hays Invitational.

Victoria scored 16 team points to earn the championship but Norton was right behind them with 14 points. Third place went to Hays High with 13, followed by Colby, 8, fourth and Russell, 2, fifth.

The two doubles teams from Norton were really on top of their game, winning both divisions. Seniors Ashley Hildebrand and Jessica White won No.1 doubles and senior Rickele Green and junior Molly Scott won No.2 doubles.

Junior Brooke Sumner placed third in No.1 singles and sophomore Audrie Burge finished fourth at No.2 singles.

"It was another hot day for playing tennis," said coach Green.

"We did get some cloud cover for part of the meet, which helped a lot. We played a bracketed double elimination tournament and finished second on the strength of our doubles teams.

"Ashley and Jessica marched through the No.1 doubles bracket. They had a tough match in the first round with Victoria's Bailey Hobbs and Breanna Leiker. They hung in there, didn't give up and came from behind to win 6-4. In the second round, they sent Colby's Samantha Lindberg and Sarah Lamm to the back side with a 6-3 victory.

"Colby won the back side so

we played them again in the finals. This time, we had a dominating 6-0 victory!

"In No.2 doubles, Rickele and Molly were awesome. In the first round against Bailey Dollison and Erin Risher of Russell, they won easily 6-0. In their second match with Emily McPherson and Ashley Cossaart of Hays, they fell behind but kept playing and slowly worked their way back into the match and came from behind to win 6-4. In the finals, they saw Anna Schmidtberger and Madisyn Gerhardt of Victoria and shut them out 6-0 in an outstanding match.

"In No.1 singles, Brooke lost 6-2 to Victoria's Brooke Schmidt, who went on to win the bracket. In her second match, Brooke won 6-2 over Rhett Brown, Russell. She made it to the finals of the back side versus Julie Balzar, Hays, but lost 6-2 to place third.

"Audrie lost her first match at No.2 singles to Maegan Karlin, Victoria, by a 6-2 score. In the second round, she was up against Carolyn Patrick who she had lost to the Saturday before in WaKeeney. It was a close match that went to a tiebreaker. Audrie won the tiebreaker 7-5. She lost her next match versus Madison Rogers, Colby, by a 6-2 score and placed fourth.

Next action

The Norton varsity will play in the Phillipsburg Quad today, beginning at 1 p.m.

Competing, in addition to Norton and Phillipsburg, will be teams from Russell and Trego Community.

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




