Four Huskies named to Liberty League team

The Northern Valley High School football team finished the 2013 season with a 5-4 record under head coach Chuck Fessenden, and four starters were named first team on the Western Kansas Liberty League 2013 All-League team.

They are senior guard Ian Vincent, senior quarterback Hunter Chandler, senior running back Jordan Baird and junior defensive lineman Phillip Bryant.

"Ian, Hunter and Jordan have been a big part of our program over the past three years," said head coach Chuck Fessenden.

Vincent earned first team honors despite playing in only five games this season. He suffered a season ending ankle injury on October 4 in the Beloit-St. John's game. The injury required surgery, but even with the abbreviated season, Vincent's play garnered the respect of the league's coaches.

"Ian saw significant playing time as a freshman and has been a great player for us during his last three years of football," said coach Fes-Reaping the benefits of Vincent's stellar

blocking were Hunter Chandler and Jordan Baird, who racked up huge offensive numbers on the season. Chandler had respectable passing numbers with 43 completions on 84 attempts for 571

the big numbers came with the ground game. In nine games, Chandler carried the ball 154 times for 1,036 yards and 17 touchdowns, and averaged 115.1 yards per game

yards, 11 touchdowns and two interceptions. But

Baird amassed 935 rushing yards on 138 carries, 13 touchdowns, and averaged 103.9 yards per game. Baird also received first team All-League honors as a return specialist. He averaged 25 yards on 16 kickoffs, with a long run of 78 yards. On punt returns, he averaged 14.50 yards with a long return of 40 yards.

"Hunter and Jordan have really produced for us on the offensive side of the ball. Their graduation is going to leave a huge whole for us to fill in the backfield. They are all fine young men and I have enjoyed coaching them," said Fessenden.

Defensively, Phillip Bryant was the only Husky named to the first team. Bryant, at 5'7" and 156 pounds, has been a force on the defensive line for the Huskies. Bryant led the team with 66 solo tackles, 79 total tackles, and 8.8 tackles

Bryant will be expected to fill part of the void on offense with the graduation of Chandler and Baird. The junior rushed for 736 yards on 99 rushes, 14 touchdowns, and a team best 7.43 yards per carry average.

"Phillip had a great year on both sides of the ball and we are looking forward to a very productive season from him next year."

"I was very proud of how our wrestlers competed," said Norton assistant coach Shane

"Although we only placed three wrestlers, the St. Francis Invitational is a challenging tournament to begin the season with the second team.

"A lot of positives came out of this early season tournament and to score 56 points with our young competitors is not bad.

"In the lower weights, Skylar Johnson, 106 and Kade Un-

terseher, 113, proved to be very solid. Skylar recorded two falls on his way to the championship match with Tate Withington of Goodland. Skylar controlled the final match with a 6-2 decision. At 113, Kade Unterseher went 3-1 with his only loss coming to the eventual champion, Colby Duncan from Sterling, in the semifinals. Duncan is a returning state medalist from a year ago when he placed fourth in Class 4A in the Colorado State Championships.




