NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 211, NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS (NORTON COMMUNITY SCHOOLS)

The Board of Education of Unified School District No. 211, Norton County, Kansas (Norton Community Schools) (the "District"), has heretofore, pursuant to resolution duly adopted, declared it advisable to: (a) construct, equip and furnish additions to the existing Eisenhower Elementary School in the District to create new kindergarten, early childhood, and art classrooms, new restrooms, a new multi-purpose room to also function as a storm-safe area, new concourse area, and new administration/student support area with controlled access entry for enhanced building security; (b) make renovations and improvements to certain existing areas of Eisenhower Elementary School for enhanced educational programs and improved student support; (c) construct site and parking improvements at the Eisenhower Elementary site; (d) construct, equip and furnish additions to the existing Norton Community High School and Norton Junior High School in the District to create a new and expanded student support area with controlled access entry for enhanced building security, expansion of the Stull Gym lobby area to create a new food service area with new kitchen and expanded cafeteria/concourse area, restrooms, a new band a vocal music area to also function as a storm-safe area, and new locker rooms at Stull Gym and other support areas; (e) make renovations and other improvement to certain existing areas of Norton Community High School and Norton Junior High School for enhanced educational programs and improved student support; (f) demolish certain areas of the existing facilities to accommodate the proposed improvements; (g) make improvements to District facilities, including but not limited to, wheelchair accessible seating at the East Campus Gym and also conversion of the existing Weight Room to a District Office, Stull Gymnasium ventilation upgrades, electrical receptacles in classrooms, and partial replacement of roofs at District attendance centers; (h) make all other necessary improvements appurtenant thereto (collectively, the "Project"); and (i) pay costs of issuance and interest on said general obligation bonds of the District during construction of the Project, at an estimated cost of \$14,825,000. Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the District that a bond election has been called and will be held on April 1, 2014, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the District the following proposition:

Shall the following be adopted? ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
The following additional information is provided by the District with respect to compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 10-120a and K.S.A. 12-6,122. This information has been obtained from sources deemed reliable by the District. Certain portions of this information is based upon projections. No assurances can be given that these projections will be accurate as of the date of issuance of the bonds due to changing market conditions, any changes in assessed valuation of the District, changes in the amount of state financial aid received by the District and other matters unknown or unavailable at this time. The projected rates of property taxation to be used to pay the principal of and interest on the Bonds are based upon the current assessed valuation of the District, the assumed principal repayment schedule and the average interest rates for recent bond issues for similar types of financings and the current level of state financial aid the District would receive with respect to the bonds, all as shown below.

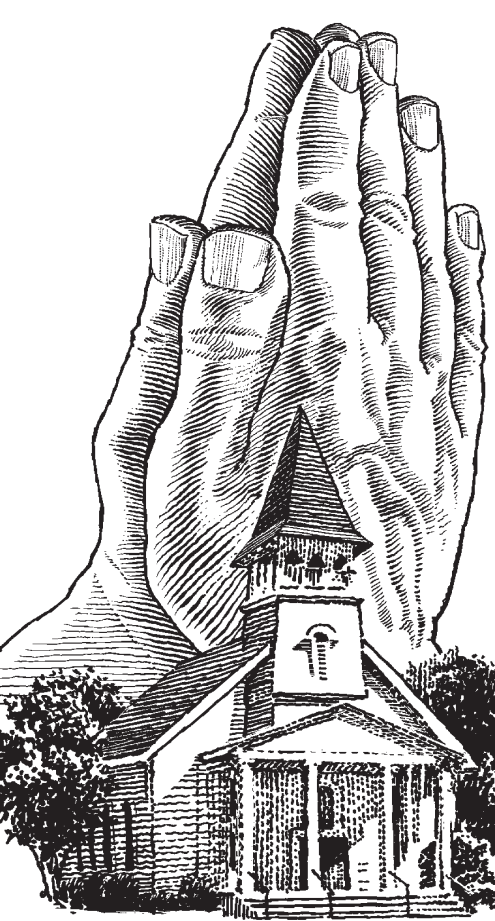
