ORDINANCE NUMBER 428  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE WITHIN THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS, AND IMPOSING IMPOUNDMENT FEES BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. That Section 2-206 of the Code of the City of Almena, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:  
"RUNNING AT LARGE; FINE.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for the owner or harbinger of any dog to permit such dog to run at large within the City at any time;
- (b) Any dog running at large within the City shall be impounded as set out in Section 2-207 of the Almena City Code;
- (c) The fine for the first offense of permitting a dog to run at large shall be \$50.00; for a second and subsequent offense, the fine for permitting a dog to run at large shall be \$100.00;
- (d) A minimum boarding bill of \$21.00 per day shall be imposed upon the owner or harbinger of any dog impounded for running at large and the Court shall assess the same as Court costs. The owner or harbinger shall, in addition to the foregoing fines and costs, pay the annual registration fees as set forth in Section 2-201 of the City Code."

SECTION TWO. Section 2-207, subsection (f), of the Code of the City of Almena is hereby amended to read as follows:  
(f) The minimum impoundment (pick up) fee shall be \$50.00 per day."

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall be published in the official City newspaper and take effect upon publication.
