

Youth Soccer in second week of play

On Saturday, April 5, 2014 the AYSO Region 1365 Youth Soccer Organization played their second week of soccer.

The results for Saturday's games were as follows:

Division U6 - Team Meyer, also known as White Fox 4 faced Team Ruiz and came out on top by a score of 6-2. Making goals for White Fox 4 were #2- McKenna with 5 goals, and 1 goal by #4 Isernhagen. Team Ruiz fought hard scoring goals with 1 by #4 Hansen and 1 for #5 Ruiz.
