Boys win big at Norton Invitational meet

nortontelegram@nwkansas.com Coach Jason Jones' Norton Community High School 2014 track and field team opened varsity competition on Friday with excellent team scores in their Norton Invitational Track Meet on the Jep Byrum Track at Travis Field.

The Blue Jay boys outdistanced Oberlin to win the championship and the Lady Jays just missed a championship, finishing just two points behind Colby.

The Norton boys scored 154 points, followed by Oberlin, 137; Northern Valley, 131; Colby, 62; Smith Center, 27; Logan, 14.

The Colby girls totaled 142 points, followed by Norton, 140; Oberlin, 113; Logan, 74; Northern Valley, 58; Smith Center, 22.

Coach's comments

"Our athletes did an excellent job in this season opening meet," said Norton head coach Jason Jones. "The weather was great and they enjoyed and took advantage of that!

"Through the day, we had a lot of positive surprises and had a lot of very solid performances for this early in the season. That is exciting!

"Our girls took second by only two points and our boys won in a commanding fashion.

"We are proud of our athletes and look forward to our next meet."

GIRLS

Senior Bailey Ambrosier started where she left off last season in the pole vault, winning it with a clearance of 10'6". Bailey also placed runner-up in the 400 meter dash with a clocking of 1:04.55.

She was also a member of the 4 x 800 meter relay team with senior Katelyn Engelbert, junior Sierra Griffith and sophomore Casey Ambrosier. They placed runner-up with a time of 10:57.35.

The same foursome finished third in the 4 x 400 meter relay with a clocking of 4:29.09.

Griffith won the 300 meter hurdles in her first time competing in the event. She was timed in 50 seconds flat.

The Lady Jays' other gold medal winner was freshman Baylee Miller who won the high jump by clearing 5'. Earning points in the distance races was senior Darcy Bainter,

who twice placed runner-up to Colby's Andrea Browne, whose family had the Browne's Store in Norton for many years.

Darcy was timed in a personal best 6:01.61 in the 1600 meter run and in 13:12.12 in the 3200 meter run.

Norton's 4 x 100 meter relay team of Miller, Engelbert, junior Kenzie Esslinger and freshman Caitlyn Cox placed third in 53.98.

Esslinger also placed runnerup behind Ambrosier in the pole vault with a clearance of 9' and freshman Miah Melvin finished fourth with a height of 8'.

The Lady Jays scored 18 points in the triple jump. Casey Ambrosier placed runner-up with a distance of 31'7.5". Sophomore Peyton Renner finished third with a 30'6" leap and Miller was fourth with a distance of 28'6.75".

Engelbert placed third in the 800 meter run in 2:43.42.

Lady Jay junior Burgundy Sorter finished fourth in the 100 meter dash in 14.75 and fourth in the 100 meter hurdles in 20.86.

Cox was fifth in the 200 meter dash in 29.18 and sixth in the 400 meter dash in 1:10.52.

Sophomore Lexi Voss scored points in two field events. She placed third in the discus with a throw of 91'8" and third in the javelin with a personal best distance of 96'10".

Renner leaped 14'1.75" to place fourth in the long jump.

Griffith finished fifth in the 1600 meter run in 6:18.59 and sophomore Raenee Patterson placed sixth in the 3200 meter run in 14:30.89.

Senior Travis Cressler placed first in the javelin throw with a personal best distance of

142'4". Norton's 4 x 100 meter relay team of Hager, junior Kobie Unterseher, sophomore Jordan Dole and sophomore Tevin Brown placed first with a time of 45 46

Boser and junior Conor Cox also finished first in 3:49.43.

Freshman Nate Hartwell began his high school career by running away from the field in the 3200 meter run with a time of 11:48.18.

Brown was the Blue Jays' other gold medal winner. He hit the finish first in the 100 meter dash in 11.61.

Finishing runner-up were senior Tanner Furbush, 39'6", triple jump; Lewis, personal best 20'3", long jump; junior Deon Lyle, 5'8", high jump; Jacob Green, 113'6", discus and a second 4x 100 meter relay team of junior Derick Campbell, sophomore Gavin Lively, Lewis and Furbush in 46.77.

Sophomore Ryan Thrailkill scored points in two races. He placed third in the 1600 meter run in 5:41.83 and fifth in the 800 meter run in 2:44.03.

Freshman Koby McEwen tallied points in three events. He placed runner-up in the high jump with a clearance of 5'8", was fifth in the triple jump with a personal best distance of 35'7" and fifth in the 300 meter hurdles with a personal best 48.81.

Cox was third in the discus with a personal best throw of 109'6".

Lyle also placed fourth in the triple jump with a distance of 36'4.5".
