You are hereby notified that a petition has been filed in this court alleging that the child named above is a Child in Need of Care. The Court may find that the parents are unfit by reason or conduct or condition which renders the parents unable to care properly for a child, the conduct or condition is unlikely to change in the foreseeable future, the parental rights of the parent should be terminated, and a permanent custodian should be appointed for the child.

A hearing on the petition is scheduled for the 16th day of July, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. At the hearing the Court may issue orders relating to the care, custody and control of the child. The hearing will determine if the parents should be deprived of their parental rights and the right to custody of the child.

The parent(s), and any other person having legal custody are required to appear before this Court on the date

and time shown, or to file your written response to the petition with the Clerk of the District Court prior to that time. Failure to respond or to appear before the Court at the time shown will not prevent the Court from entering judgment as requested in the petition, finding that the child is a Child in Need of Care, removing the child from the custody of parent, parents or any other present legal custodian until further order of the Court, or finding the parents unfit, and entering an order permanently terminating the parents' parental rights.

You have the right to appear before the Court and be heard personally, either with or without an attorney. The Court will appoint an attorney for any parent who desires an attorney but is financially unable to hire one. The Court may order one or both parents to pay child support.

A RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH A HEARING DATE ON THE MATTER OF CERTAIN PROPERTIES THAT MAY BE UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS

WHEREAS, KSA 12-1750 et seq, provides a procedure for ordering the repair or removal of dangerous structures; and,

WHEREAS, the enforcing officer has filed a statement with the governing body pursuant to said ordinance declaring that the structure at 18204 Cedar Street in the City of Clayton is unsafe or dangerous;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, KANSAS, that:

SECTION 1. A hearing date of August 4th, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. is hereby set for the owner(s) of the structures at 18204 Cedar Street, or any agent, lien holder or occupant of such structures to appear and show cause why said structures should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished.

SECTION 2. This notice shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper. At least 30 days shall elapse after its last publication and the date set for the hearing.

SECTION 3. A copy of this resolution shall be mailed within three days after its first publication to the owner, agent, lien holder and/or occupant at their last known place of residence and shall be marked as "deliver to addressee only".

ORDINANCE NUMBER 429

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF WEED NUISANCES WITHIN THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. That Section 8-402 of the Code of the City of Almena, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"DEFINITIONS. WEEDS as used herein, means any of the following:

- (a) Brush and woody vines shall be classified as weeds;
- (b) Weeds and indigenous grasses which may attain such large growth as to become, when dry, a fire menace to adjacent improved property;
- (c) Weeds which bear or may bear seeds of a downy or wingy nature;
- (d) Weeds which are located in an area which harbors rats, insects, animals, reptiles, or any other creature which either may or does constitute a menace to health, public safety or welfare; or
- (e) Weeds and indigenous grasses on or about residential property which, because of its height, has a blighting influence on the neighborhood. Any such weeds and indigenous grasses shall be presumed to be blighting if they exceed 8 inches in height."

SECTION TWO. This ordinance shall be published in the official City newspaper and take effect upon publication.

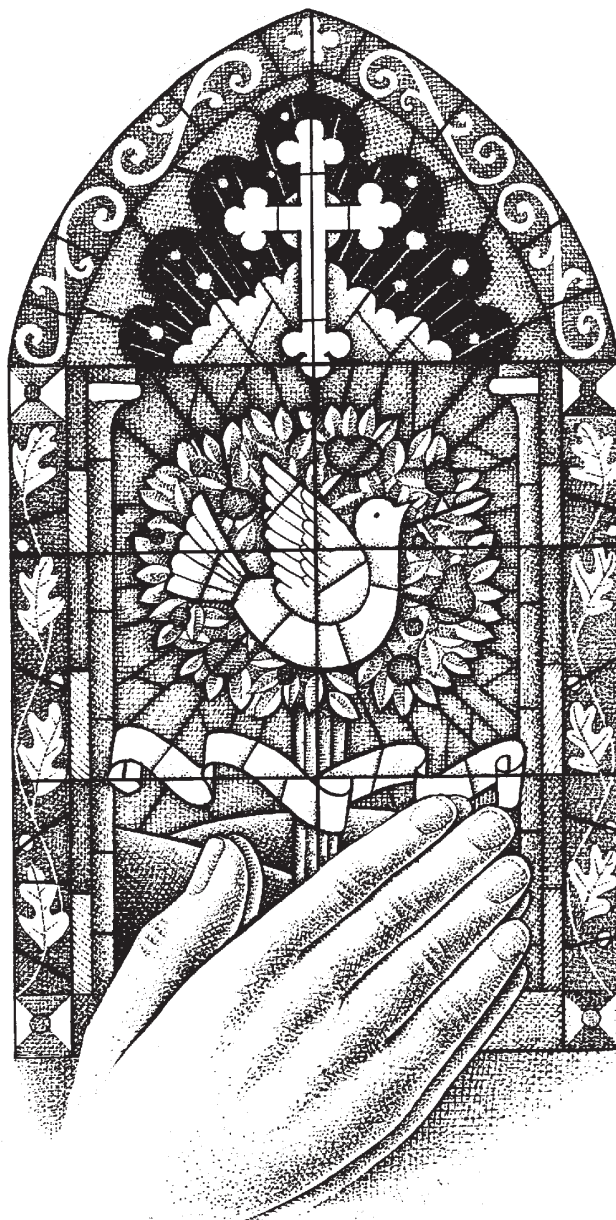
