

# Legion loses doubleheader to Redmen

The Norton American Legion baseball team was outscored 9-2 and 11-3 in a double header with Smith Center on Wednesday, June 11 at John Ryan Field.

Norton's starting pitcher Toby Nickell limited the Redmen to just 3 runs in the first two innings but the Blue Jays went scoreless during that time.

Gavin Lively took over pitching duties for Norton in the top of the third but the Redmen added 2 more runs to stretch their lead to 5-0.

Norton scored their only 2 runs in the bottom of the fifth when Jacob Green doubled for only the third hit of the contest for the Blue Jays and Trevor Lewis singled him home to make it 5-2.

With Lively still hurling, Smith Center was held scoreless in the fourth, fifth and sixth innings but Norton was unable to score themselves. In the top of the seventh, the Redmen tallied 4 more runs for the final 9-2 win.

Norton had only 5 hits, 4 bases on balls and 5 strike outs. Leading hitter was Trevor Lewis, who went 2 for 3.

Toby Nickell was the losing pitcher.

Smith Center had 7 hits, 9 walks and 5 strike outs.

### Nightcap

Andrew Ellis pitched three innings for Norton in the second game. During that period, the Redmen scored 2 runs in the first

and 2 in the third inning for a 4-0 lead.

Norton cut the visitors' lead to 4-3 with runs in the bottom of the third. Lane Bigge walked, Austin Hager got on base on an error, Jacob Brooks reached first when the Smith Center catcher interfered with a pitch to him, Trevor Lewis singled, Andrew Ellis and Dalton Miller walked, Jacob Green got on base on a fielder's choice and Toby Nickell walked. Hager, Brooks and Lewis crossed home plate.

Jacob Green relieved Ellis on the mound after three innings. The visiting Redmen added 3 more runs in the fourth inning and 4 more in the fifth while holding Norton scoreless the rest of the way for the 11-3 victory.

Norton had just 1 hit in the game, 7 walks and 5 strike outs. Trevor Lewis's single in the bottom of the third inning was the Blue Jays' only hit.

Andrew Ellis was the losing pitcher.

Smith Center had 6 hits, 12 walks and 8 strike outs.

Norton head coach Scott Ellis was disappointed in his team's performance. "We made numerous mistakes, they made just one error and they won," he said.

Norton will host Holdrege this evening, Tuesday, June 17 at John Ryan Field with another double header, beginning at 6 p.m. and 8 p.m.

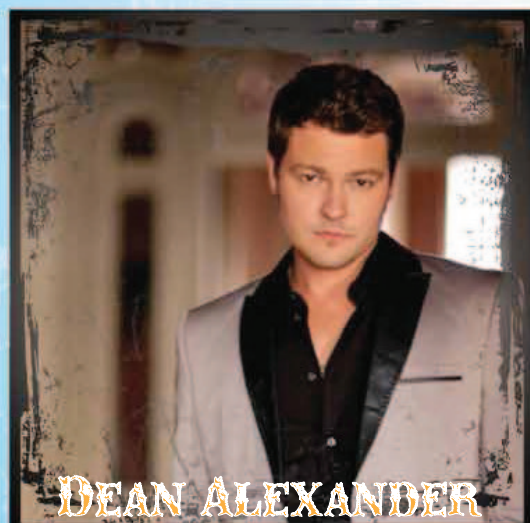

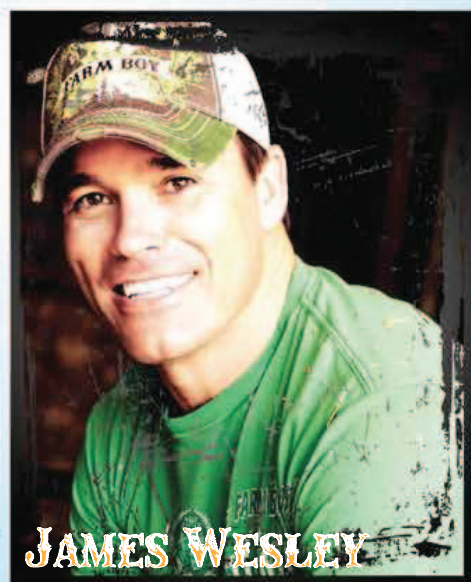
