PSALM 100

"SHOUT FOR JOY TO THE LORD, ALL THE EARTH. WORSHIP THE LORD WITH GLADNESS; COME BEFORE HIM WITH JOYFUL SONGS. KNOW THAT THE LORD IS GOD. IT IS HE WHO MADE US, AND WE ARE HIS; WE ARE HIS PEOPLE, THE SHEEP OF HIS PASTURE. **ENTER HIS GATES WITH THANKSGIVING** AND HIS COURTS WITH PRAISE; GIVE THANKS TO HIM AND PRAISE HIS NAME. FOR THE LORD IS GOOD AND HIS LOVE ENDURES FOREVER; HIS FAITHFULNESS CONTINUES THROUGH ALL **GENERATIONS.**"

Psalm 100 is indeed a psalm of praise. Thus, this passage of Scripture should be wholeheartedly looked to when considering what true thanksgiving to God is all about.

The Hebrew word for "shout" literally means with an expression that can be easily heard, you are to shout for joy to the Lord. Just as Norton Bluejay fans shout for joy when their home town team makes a touchdown in a football game, Spiritfilled, born again Christians are to give a loud praise unto the Lord for His great works. In all places of Christian service, whether in private, families or public worship He is to be given joyful praise.

The psalmist reminds us that the Lord is the only true living God. His loves endures forever, His faithfulness continues through all generations.

What type of songs get your adoration, money and time? Whose praises are constantly upon your lips?
