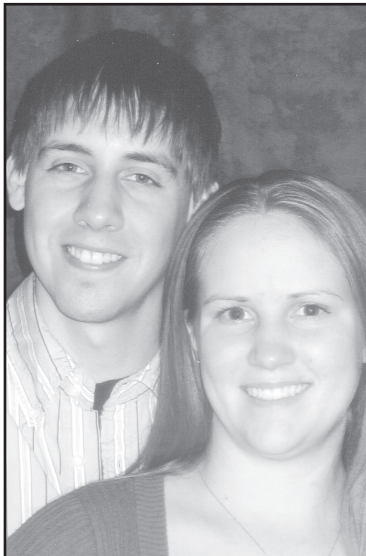


Couple plans wedding

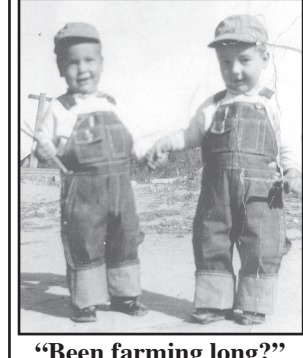

Goodland police search for suspect

An apparent assault on a woman about 8 a.m. on Monday had Goodland police officers, Sherman County sheriff's deputies and a state trooper searching the area around Steever Park for the suspect who ran away. Police were called to 1519 Cherry, Goodland, about 8 a.m. with report of an assault on a woman. She was walking up to the house when she was grabbed and assaulted by a man wielding a large knife. The woman told police the man was hiding near the house next door and grabbed her saying he would kill her if she did not do as he said. The woman broke free and ran to the house, and the suspect took off running to the south. At first it was reported the woman was stabbed, but later it was corrected that she had been

assaulted and the man had a large knife that he threatened her with. The man was described as being 6-foot tall, white, age 20-25, slender build, short dark hair, no glasses, no facial hair and having a big nose. He was wearing black pants and a black jacket. The man was apparently carrying a large knife with a gold handle and the blade was 8- to 12-inches long. Schools, day care centers and other places were notified and put on lock down as the search continued. Residents in the suspected area were notified by phone to be on the lookout for the man. Reports were the man ran south, and the deputies and police were searching the area around and south of the city power plant. The sheriff said the case is still under investigation.
