

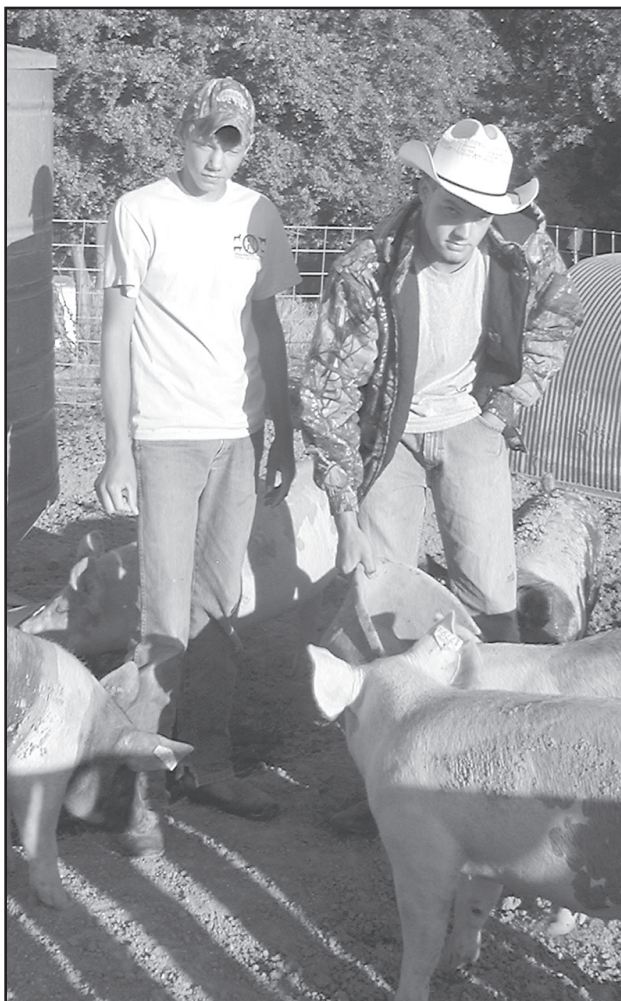
Boys enrolled in hog project

So she went from calf pen to the internet where she began shopping for something to wear to the 4-H Style Revue to be held Monday, Aug. 3.

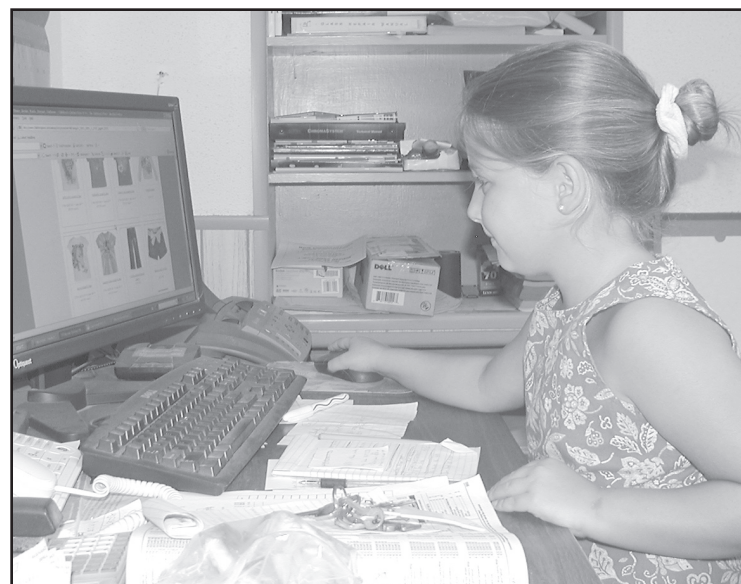
Audrey's mother said after she had helped her the first time, she began looking on her own. She and her mom, after discussing exactly what she might want, ordered the clothes.
