The antlers keep away predators and other reindeer away. — Tyson Poling

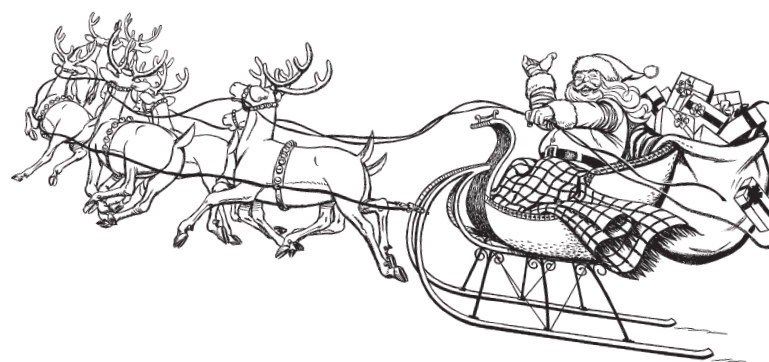
The antlers keep away others, to help reindeer fly and pull the sled. Santa can also ride them! — Kallen Feikert

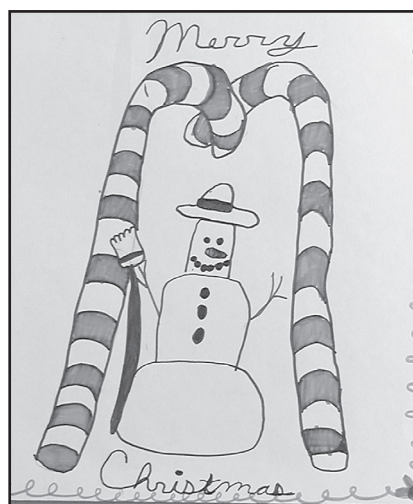
