Notice is hereby given that pursuant to K.S.A. 25-2018 as amended, a General School Election to elect three (3) School Board Members shall be conducted in Unified School District No. 297, Cheyenne County, State of Kansas, on the 3rd day of April, 2007.

The District has the three (3) district election, one (1) Board Member being elected from each of the three (3) Board Districts and one (1) Member-at-large, therefore there shall be one (1) Board Member elected from Board Member District No. 1, Position No. 1; one Board Member from District No. 2, Position No. 2 and one (1) Board Member from District No. 3, Position No. 3 and one (1) Member-at-large, Position No. 7. Each Board Member shall be a qualified elector of the Member District for which they file as a candidate. Board Members shall be elected for a term of four (4) years beginning the first day of July, 2007. Candidates shall file for such office with the County Clerk/County

Election Officer of Cheyenne County, Kansas. Each such filing shall be made before 12 noon on Tuesday, January 23rd, 2007. Each such filing shall be accompanied by a filing fee of five (\$5.00) dollars or by a petition signed by not less than 50 electors in the Member District, or 10% of the qualified electors in the Member District, whichever is less. No candidate shall be permitted to withdraw his candidacy after the last date provided by law for filing for such candidacy.

Notice is further given that if more than two (2) candidates file for any one position on the Board, there shall be conducted a Primary Election on February 27th, 2007 in the Member District or Districts having more than two (2) candidates. Names of the two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes for each position at the Primary Election, if one is held, shall be placed on the ballot in the Board Member District for which there are candidates, at the General School Election held on Tuesday, April 3, 2007.
