Area residents are saddened by the tragedy that occurred last week. So many go on about their daily chores without thinking of how quickly tragedy can strike. The Rawlins County Sheriff's department and ambulances responded to a call of someone having been run over by a loader tractor on the afternoon of Thursday, Jan. 25 at the Mike Sramek farm approximately 10 miles north of McDonald.

On the scene they found Carol Sramek age 53 had been run over by a loader tractor. Emergency services responded as well but Mrs. Sramek was pronounced dead at the scene. No one knows for sure how the accident happened but some think maybe she slipped on the ice and fell out of sight behind the tractor.

Mrs. Sramek was a loving wife and mother who will be greatly missed by many.

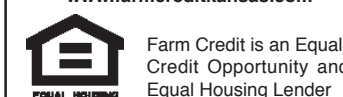

Kansans for Life

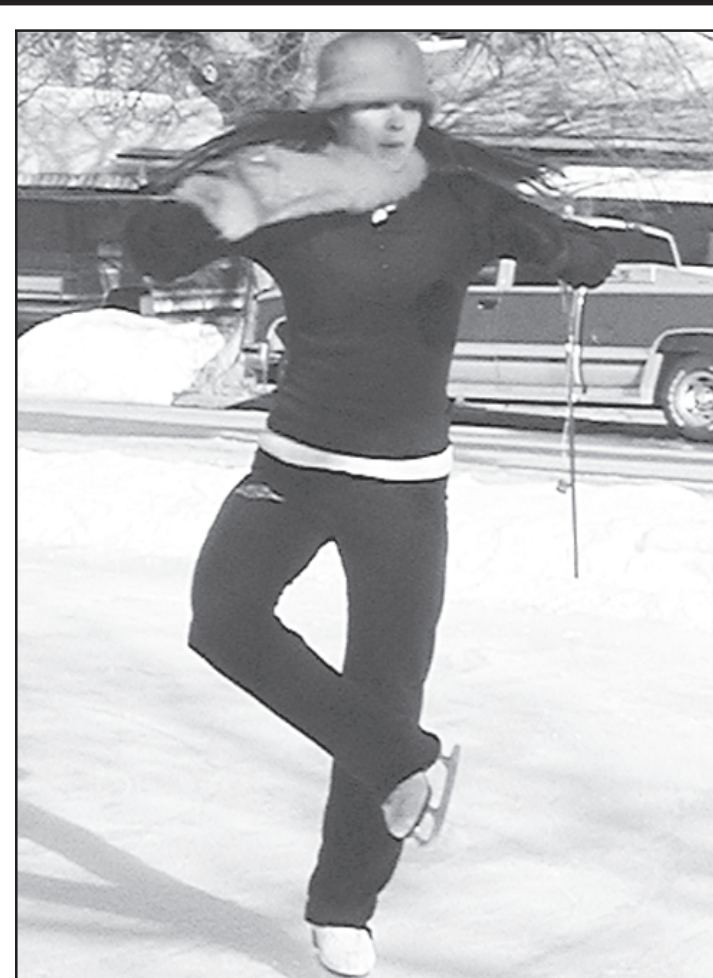
