She was a member of Peace Lutheran Church, always willing to lend a helping hand. Hilda loved to play bridge and always enjoyed opening her home to family and friends.


Hilda was preceded in death by her sisters, Marie Krug and Freda Deines, and brothers, Raymond and Hubert Dietz.
