AN IMPORTANT SAFETY MESSAGE FROM AAA

Motor vehicle crashes are the No. 1 killer of teens.

A bill that is before the Kansas House Transportation Committee right now could change that. This bill proposes to strengthen our novice, graduated driver system (GDL) of licensing.

Why is improving our novice driver licensing system so important?

- Vehicle crashes are the No. 1 killer of teens.
- 80 deaths, 7,000 injuries and 16,000 accidents per year means nearly \$630 million in accident costs for Kansas.
- Kansas is one of only five states without an intermediate stage of licensing between a permit stage and full-privilege licensing.
- Six out of 10 Kansans killed in crashes involve 15- to 17-year-old drivers.
- The greatest risks to novice drivers are driving at night and distractions of other young passengers.

crashes in other states by 25% to 50%.

- Provide a six-month intermediate stage that continues adult-supervised driving after 9 p.m. and limits the number of non-sibling passengers under the age of 21 to one passenger.
- Maintains the current Farm Permit.
- Restricts the use of wireless communication devices by novice drivers.

More than 95% of parents — and most teens — that have experienced this GDL system in other states approve of it. It's time for Kansas to join the rest of the nation in protecting our novice drivers and giving parents the tools they need. Your urgent action will encourage their support of this improvement to the Kansas GDL, which will save hundreds of lives and thousands of injuries.
