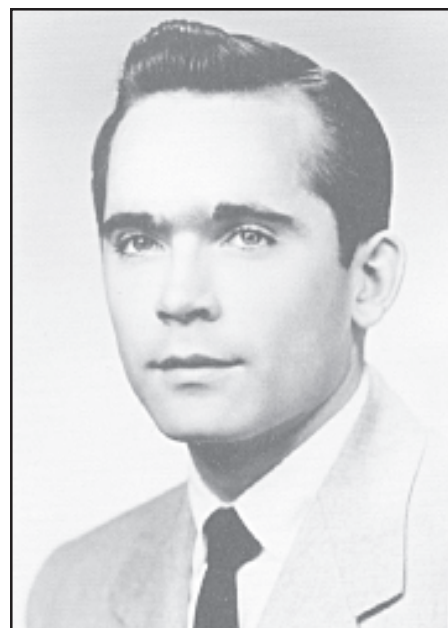
Kite family: back, E.E., Doris, Ruby; front, John and Wendell.

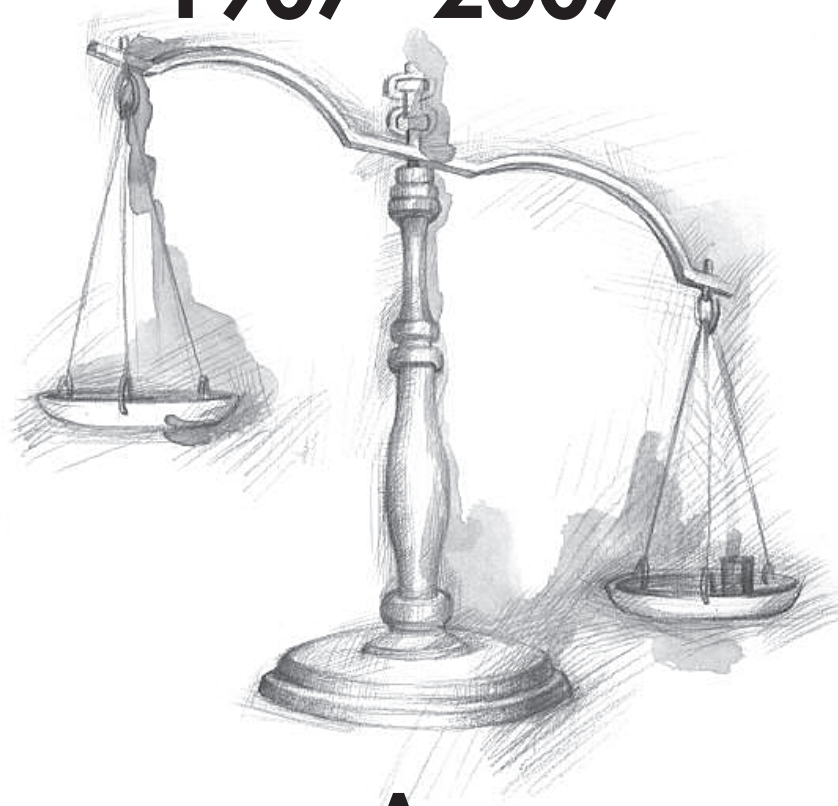


E.E. Kite, 1907, graduation from law school.



John G. Kite, 1957, graduation from law school.

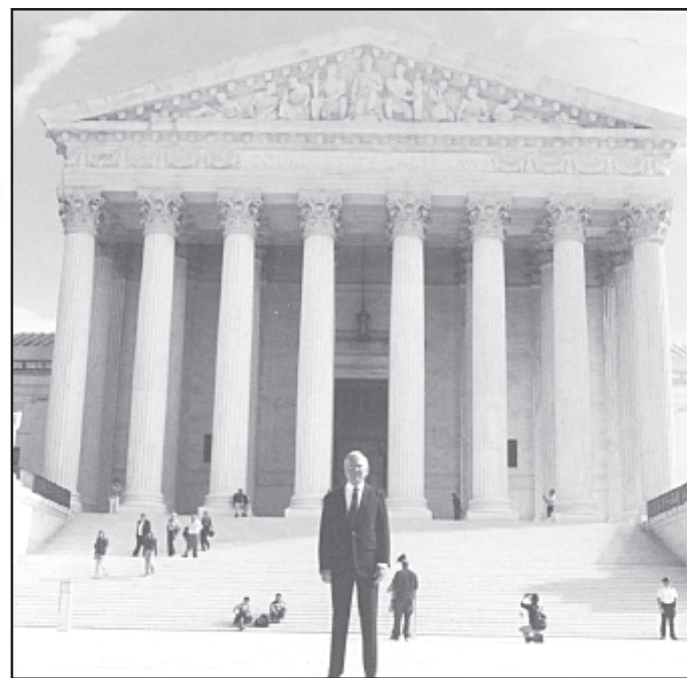

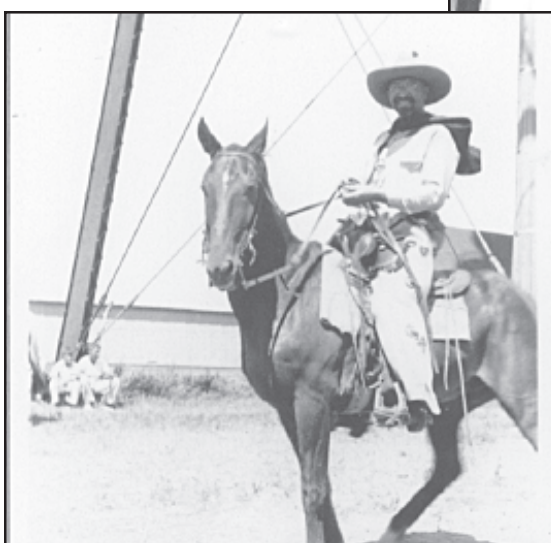
