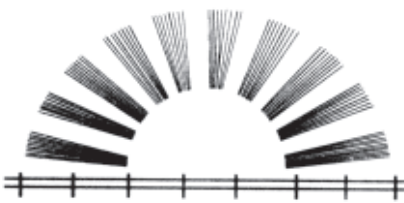

Montana cowboy to sing at show

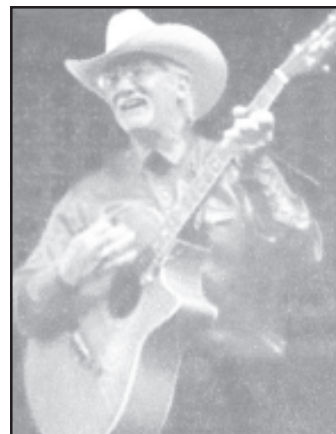

Mr. Anderson now lives in Estes Park and is the Western Music Association 2003-2004 male yodeling champion. He is also noted for his whistling, which he calls his "poor man's fiddle."

He was raised in a musical family going back to his Scottish ancestors who were troubadours for generations. He learned to play the guitar from his grandmother, who also taught him harmonica and bagpipes. His mother played him and his siblings to sleep nearly every night with honky-tonk piano music. Pops, his dad, played harmonica and

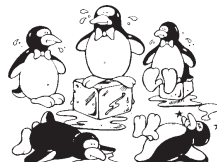
