On Sept. 1, Gov. Kathleen Sebelius appointed Craig Van Allen, St. Francis, as the Cheyenne County Sheriff. He filled the vacancy left by Troy Gardner, who resigned to continue his education.

Sheriff Gardner had recommended Mr. Van Allen to the county commissioners before he left. The commissioners had then made the recommendation to the governor.

Sheriff Van Allen came to work for the city police department as a part-time officer in January 2005; then shifted to the sheriff's department in May 2006. In May 2007, he was appointed as undersheriff. Prior to coming to St. Francis, he had been a law officer in Lindsborg.

The sheriff's department was recently relocated to the courthouse. His office will be in the old sheriff's office on the second floor. A portion of the sheriff's office will be renovated as the new 911 dispatch center and Carol Gamblin will be the communication officer.

Other sheriff's officers are Jon Lanz and Cody Beeson. Officer Beeson is the undersheriff and is basically working in the Bird City area. The deputies' office will be in

Sheriff Van Allen said he and his officers are responsible for the county residents and those in Bird City. They are on call 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
