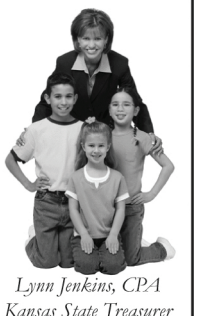
Kansas will help Pay the Bill!
