and the great American way of life.

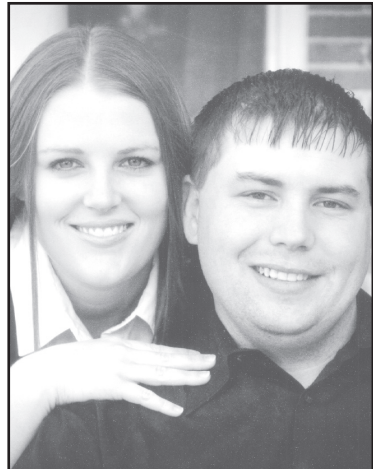
There will be a dress rehearsal Monday morning starting at 10

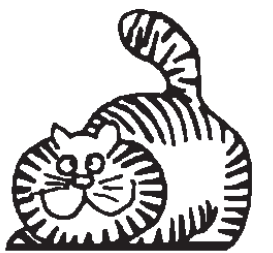
Seven guests stayed overnight with Kyle and two had dinner on Sunday with the family.
