## Skills improve weekly during wrestling season

The wrestling season ended with six St. Francis wrestlers qualify for State and four of them coming home with medals. Qualifying were Justin Sherlock, Gavin Smull, David Guthmiller, Jesse Pacheco, Darris Keller and Cody Sherlock. C. Sherlock and Pacheco placed fourth, Smull placed fifth and Guthmiller placed sixth. J. Sherlock missed the competition due to illness and Keller did not place.

Four wrestlers, J. Sherlock, Smull, D. Guthmiller and Josh Carpenter have wrestled their last match for the Sainty Indians as they are among the seniors who will graduate in May.

Other wrestlers who had at least one varsity match this season include Grady Brunk, Alex Draper, Scott Ford, Adam Guthmiller, Robbie Herman, Talon Jones, Terrence Lamb, Freddy Pacheco and Trevor Reed.

"We had four quality seniors," Coach Mike Frewen said. "They are good kids."

"We started out the season at the St. Francis Invitational, having had few practices before the tournament. We just got better each week. We were in better shape and had better fundamentals as the year went on."

"We did our best all year long, never having a dual or a tournament where we just slumped."

"We peaked and were wrestling our best at the end of the year."

"The kids need to feel good about their season. I am proud of their accomplishments."

The Indians finished second in the Northwest Kansas League in dual competition. The only team they lost to was the eventual champion, Colby. Other league members include Goodland, Hoxie, Oberlin, Oakley, Quinter and Rawlins County.

Two wrestlers earned championships at tournaments with J. Sherlock placing first at the Wray Invitational, the league tournament and at Regionals while J. Pacheco placed first at Regionals. No Indian was named a champion at the St. Francis Invitational, the Prairie Classic at Hays or the Panther Classic



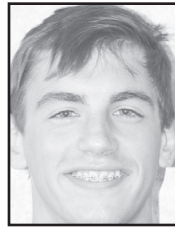

at Phillipsburg. All of these tournament had a large number of schools attending.

St. Francis also attended two dual tournaments and they came away from the Sterling Tournament with a 5-0 record while early in the year they were 1-4 in pool play at the Colby Invitational and 0-1 in final competition.

As a tournament team the Indians were fourth at St. Francis, seventh at the Wray Invitational, 10th at the Prairie Classic, fourth at the league tournament, fifth at the Panther Classic, fourth at Regionals and ninth at State.

Six wrestlers competed in at least one match at the junior varsity level this year including Grady Brunk, Alex Draper, Adam Guthmiller, Robbie Herman, Freddy Pacheco and Trevor Reed.

Brunk completed his season with a 12-0 record. He also had the most decision with 3 and the most falls with 9. Pacheco had the most takedowns (20); most technical falls (1); most major decisions (1); most three-point near falls (8); most two-point near falls (5); most reversals (9) and most escapes (4).

As a team they were 6-4 (St. Francis followed by opponents) in decisions, 17-17 in falls, 1-0 in technical falls, 1-0 in major decisions, 48-28 in takedowns, 14-7 in three-point near falls, 12-5 in two-point near falls, 17-22 in reversals and 10-21 in escapes.
