Last year when he appeared as the entertainment for the car show he was so impressed with the band shell at the city park that he came back this year free of charge to raise money for renovations to the band shell.


At the end of his show he stated that he wanted to come back next year to perform again.

Kody Krien, Krien Pharmacy, gave an informative program telling about the new Medicare rules. The hostesses for the luncheon


were Nola Burrus, Dolores Kincheloe and Margaret Shay.


