Trevor Reed is back!

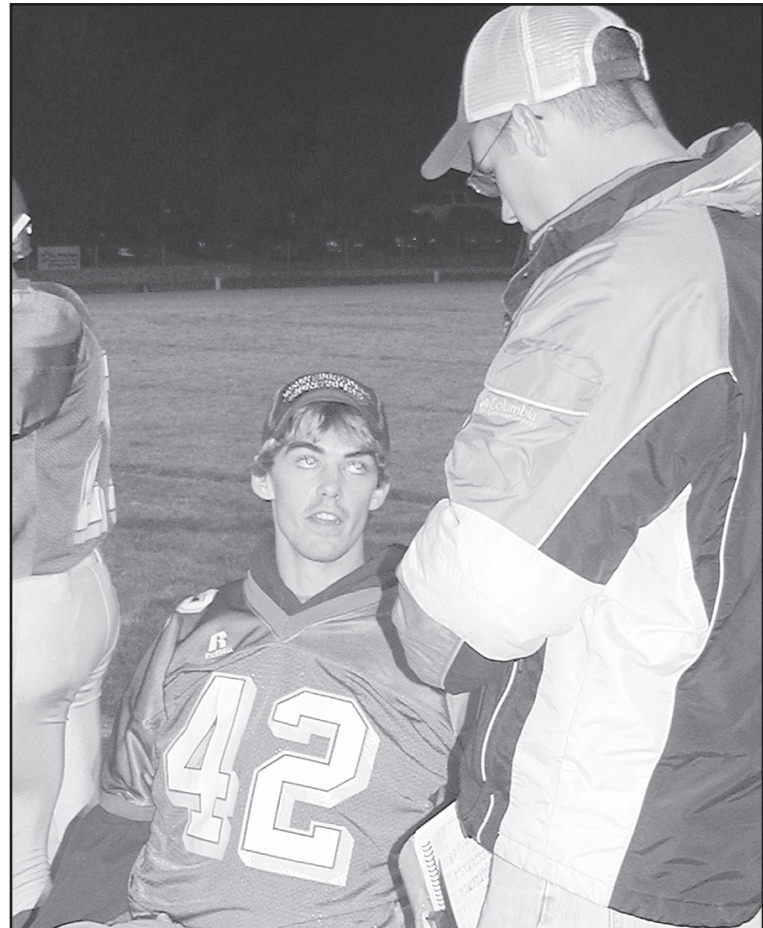
Trevor, 15, was injured in a one-car accident on Sept. 30. Trevor was rushed to the Cheyenne County Hospital and then flown to Swedish Hospital where he underwent several surgeries.

But, he is back! He made it to St. Francis in time to support his football team members at the St. Francis vs Rawlins County game on Thursday.

His mother, Lacy Reed, said he is gaining each day. He will be taking physical therapy at the Cheyenne County Hospital and is going to school a few hours a day until he has regained his strength. When he has more nerve feeling, he will be going back to Colorado for intense therapy.

Mrs. Reed said Trevor has nerve damage to the spinal cord but he has no spinal cord damage.

"He has time to heal and there is no time frame," Mrs. Reed said.
