Jacky Chacon

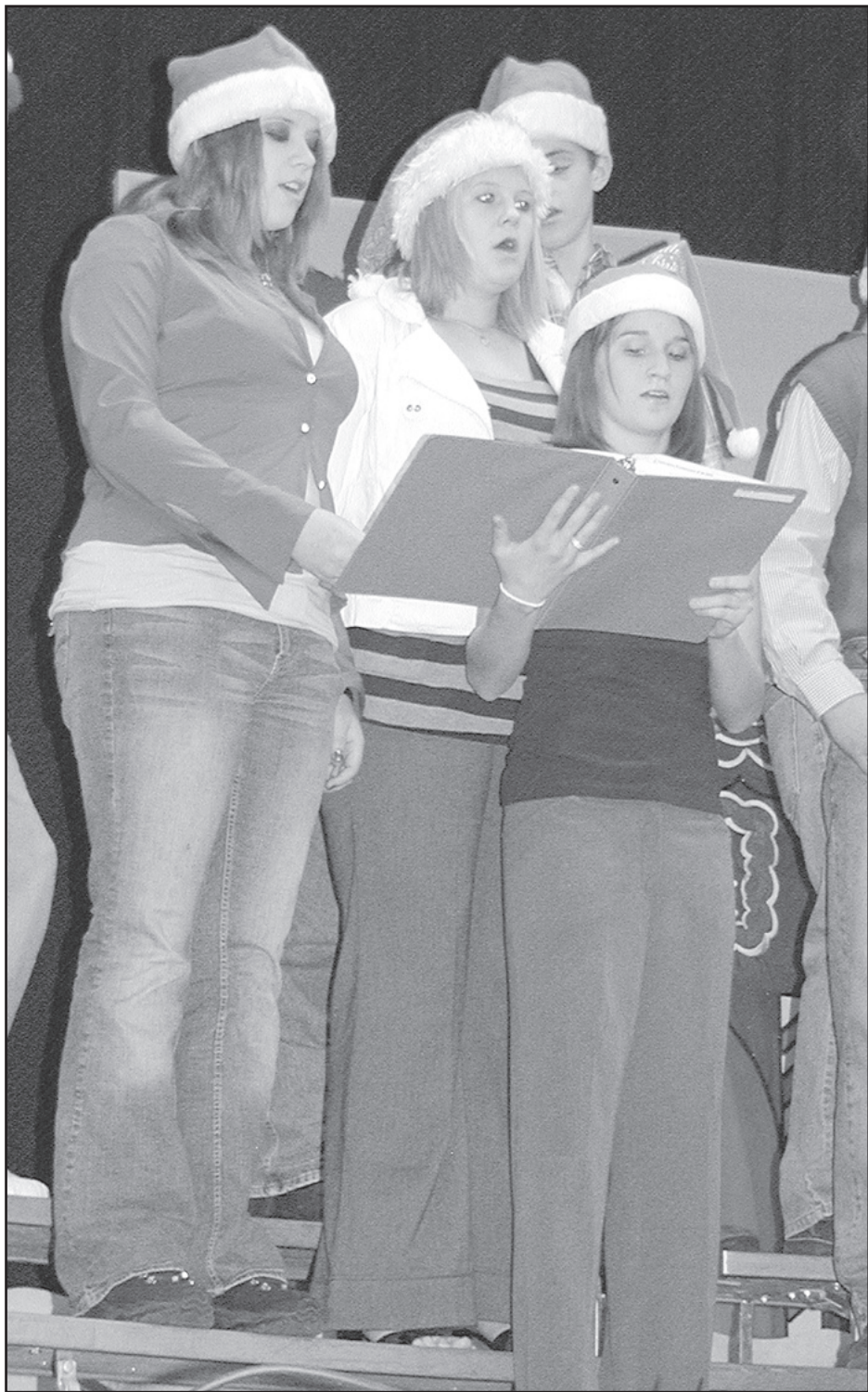

Tommy Frisbie

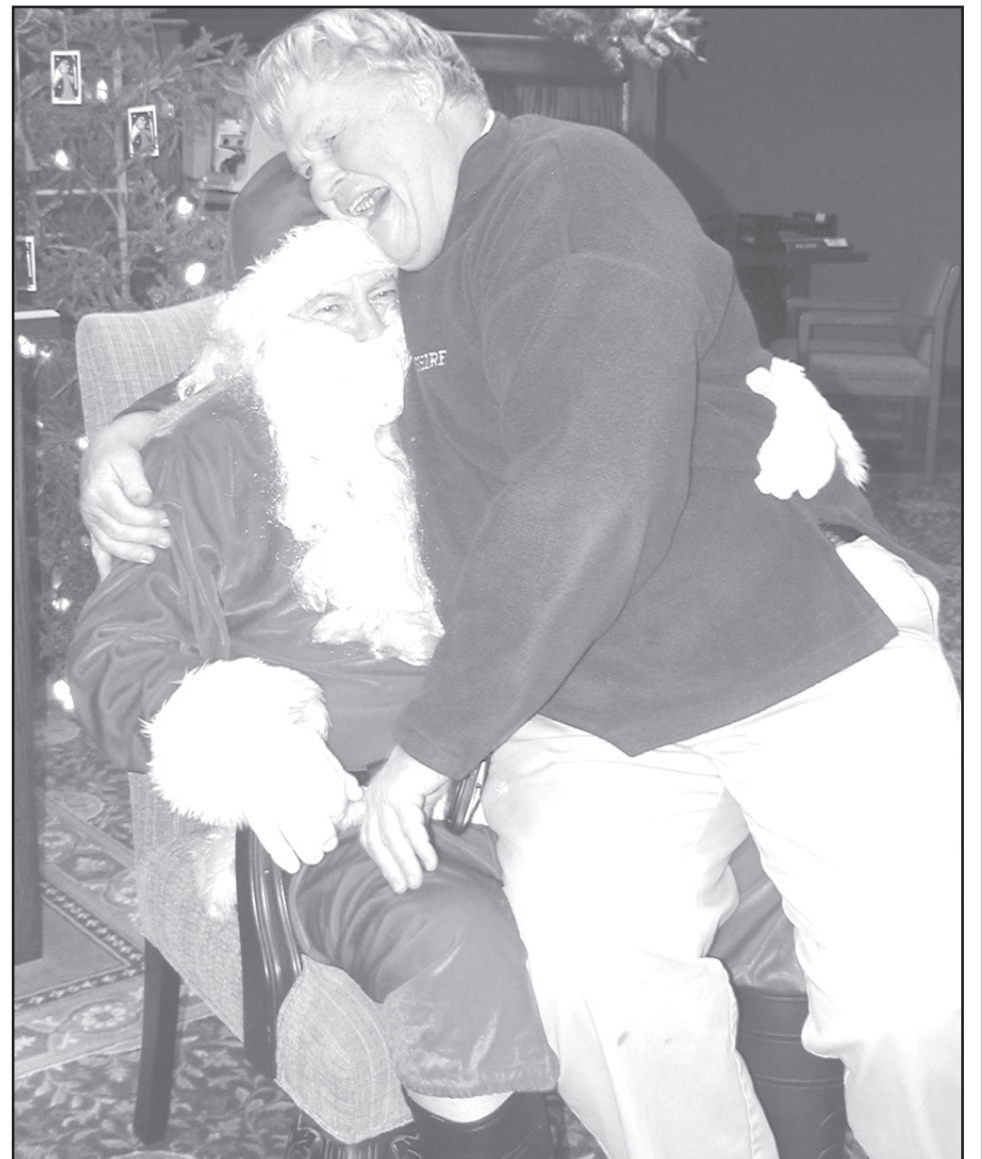
