Earned tax credit available to some

earn a lot of money may be eligible for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), as well as free help preparing their tax return. Friday, Jan. 30, marks Earaned Income Tax Credit Awareness Day, a nationwide effort to increase public awareness about the credit and free tax preparation sites.

Internal Revenue Service estimates that 20 to 25 percent of eligible taxpayers fail to claim the credit which could put as much as \$4,824 into the pockets of a family with two children, or send as much as \$2,917 to a family with one child, or up to \$438 for a worker with no children. The enue Service Taxpayer Assistance Earned Income Tax Credit is the federal government's largest program benefiting lower earning workers.


