Nabhan, author of "Coming Home to Eat: The Pleasures and Politics of Local Foods and Renewing America's Food Traditions," "Saving and Savoring the Continent's Most Endangered Foods; and Mark Winne, author of "Closing the Food Gap: Resetting the Table in the Land of Plenty.'

On Tuesday evening, prior to the conference, a "Fat and Local" soiree was held spotlighting local foods. All meals provided were prepared from items produced in the local area including elk, chicken, beef, lamb, squash, greens, beans, apples, salsa and yogurt dressing, among other items.


