Kinen placed first in both the 300-meter and the 110-meter hurdles; Raile won the 100-meter dash and the triple jump and Warren the shot put.

Sidnee Crabtree, Jenna Hill, Ashlynn Lambert, Mikaela Grace and Elizabeth Gienger all did well in the girls division as they each placed first in at least one event.

Athletes in the first six positions received team points.

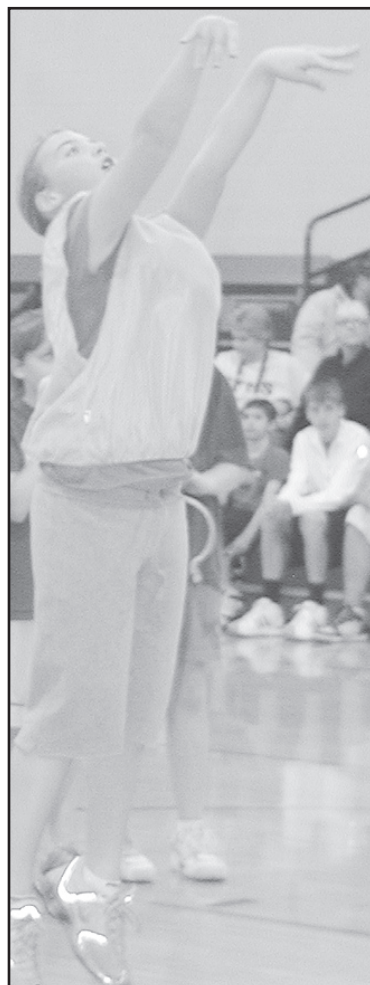
