## High prices spent for sale premiums

The 4-H/FFA Premium Sale, held Friday during the Cheyenne County Fair, found buyers, individuals and organizations supporting the kids exceptionally well.

When the final dollars were tallied, the sale brought in right at \$57,000. Paying the highest

dollar was a buyer's group (see Page 6 for list of buyers) which paid \$6,500 including paying the highest sale premium, \$2,000, on Kyla Bandel's market steer. The group also purchased the premium of \$1,500 for Grady Brunk's breeding heifer, and \$1,000 each for Martin Beikman's market hog

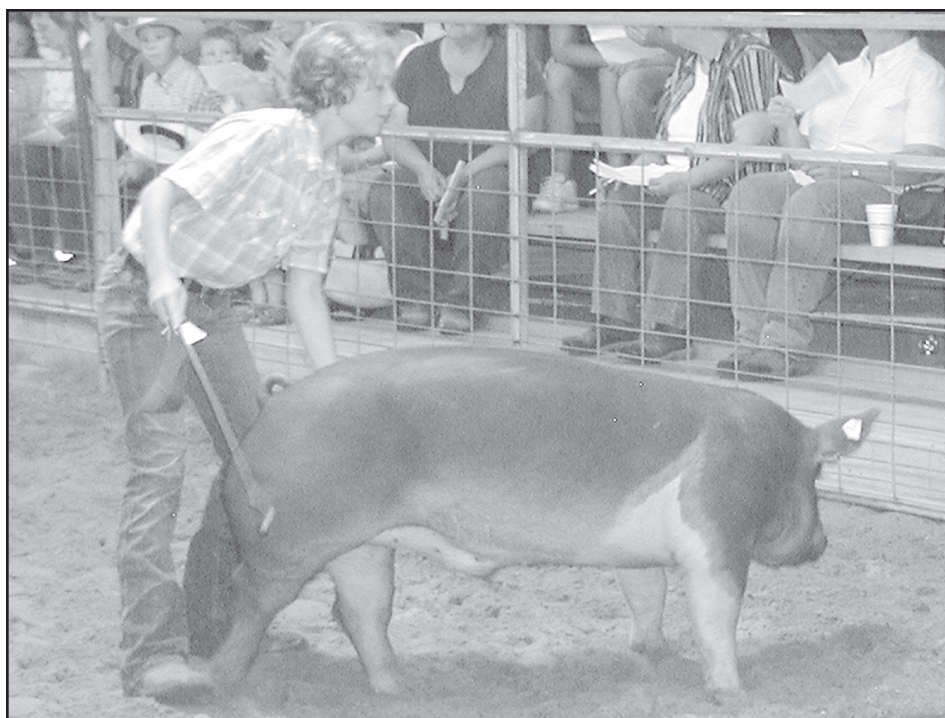
and Laura Brunk's market lamb. They also made other premium purchases.

High individual business was the St. Francis Equity which paid out \$3,825 in premiums. The highest premiums were \$1,100 to Shakotah Blanka's market steer, and \$1,000 to Matt Raile for his

market steer. Goodland Greenline, Wheeler, was also at the top, purchasing \$3,350 in premiums.

Third high premium purchase of \$1,200 was made by Mill and Seed for Lauren Bandel's Market Steer.
