

County shows wheat plot results

The Cheyenne County wheat plot was planted Sept. 24 and harvested July 9, several weeks after the Wheat Plot Field Day on June 11.

The results found the top yielding varieties for the K-State county wheat plot were Armour and Aspen, with 86.6 and 84.6 bushels per acre, respectively. The Armour test weight was 60.8 pounds

per bushel and protein was 11.3 percent. Aspen weighed in at 59.9 pounds and had 11.6 percent protein.

To finish out the top five yielding varieties, there were Winterhawk, Smokey Hill and Tam 112 with 83.1, 79.3 and 77.2 bushels per acre, respectively.

The test weights ranged from 62.7 to 59.2 pounds per bushel.

Quadris is a preventative fungicide. Leaf rust was not present on the leaves at treatment. The infection took place later in the season, so the Quadris prevented a full-blown infection.
