## Indian champions named at tourney

Senior, Terrence Lamb, and juniors, Cody Sherlock and Adam Guthmiller, won championships at the 49th annual Gabel/Jenkins Invitational Wrestling Tournament held in St. Francis on Saturday. Lamb wrestles at 135 pounds, Sherlock at 140 and Guthmiller at 189.

St. Francis, as a team, with 95 points, placed fifth for the day. Besides the three champions, senior Grady Brunk placed third for the Indians at 160 pounds and freshman Foster Grant was third at 112, while seniors Freddy Pacheco at 119 and Darris Keller at 145 placed fourth. No other Indians participated on Saturday.

Colby repeated as the team champions for the third year in a row. They collected 155 points. Coming in second was Burlington with 133 points. Others team placings were Norton, third with 115 points; Goodland, fourth with 108.5 points; St. Francis, fifth with 95 points; Rawlins County, sixth with 81 points; Wray, seventh with 52 points; Sterling, eighth with 45 points and Wichita County/Leoti, ninth with 20 points.

St. Francis, Burlington and Norton each had three champions while Colby had two and Wray and Sterling one each.

"It was a real tough tournament," Coach Mike Frewen said. "Colby, Burlington and Norton are all tough teams and Goodland is solid.

"Terrence (Lamb) had a good tournament. His semi-final match went into overtime and it is always good to win an overtime match.

"Cody (Sherlock) won first and it is always good to win. The score vs Deeds (5-4) was close but Cody was in control the whole time. He moved up three weights since last year and it didn't seem to hurt him Saturday sizewise.

"Adam (Guthmiller) defeated the kid in the finals that pinned him last year. He needs to quit putting himself in trouble but on Saturday he brought himself out of the trouble which is good.

"Grady (Brunk) did a lot of good things. He lost in the semi's but came back and got third. Being able to come back is good.

"Foster (Grant) did some good things against his Burlington opponent. His Colby opponent was a state placer last year.

"Freddy (Pacheco): I have seen him wrestle better than he did on Saturday. He has the ability, just needs his mindset.

"Darris (Keller) wrestled up and down. He wrestled well against a good kid to get in the match for third and fourth. This was his best match of the day.

"We scored more points than last year which was good with our small squad. We still have a ways to go. It will not be a sprint but improvement each week."

**Colby/Eagle Invitational**

On Friday and Saturday St. Francis will be one of 18 teams to participate in the 24th annual Colby Eagle Invitational Wrestling Tournament. The schools involved include Chaparral (Parker, Colo.), Colby, Concordia, Eagle Crest, Colo., Garden City, Goodland, Hays, Hoxie, Hutchinson, Liberal, Oakley, Decatur Community/Oberlin, Phillipsburg, Pine Creek, Colo., St. Francis, Scott City, Valley Center and Wray, Colo. The list encompasses schools from a variety of classifications.

Teams will be placed into three pools. Seedings will be determined by last year's team dual records, returning starters, individual honors and this year's schedule.

The first place teams from each pool will round-robin dual for first, second and third place. Second place teams from each pool will round-robin dual for fourth, fifth and sixth place, etc. until all team places have been determined.

**Goodland junior varsity tournament**

Five St. Francis freshmen wrestlers attended the Goodland junior varsity tournament on Saturday. Saintry had two first place finishers, Mike Leibbrandt at 112 and Dylan Wolaver at 140; two second place finishers, Casey Keller at 103 and Zach Gienger at 171 and a third place finisher, Thomas Douthit at 145.

Coach Kyle Buffington said that the young wrestlers had a good day. They wrestled well even in the matches they lost and it was a fun day for the boys.

Saintry won a total of 13 matches and lost only five. There were a number of teams involved in the action on Saturday.
