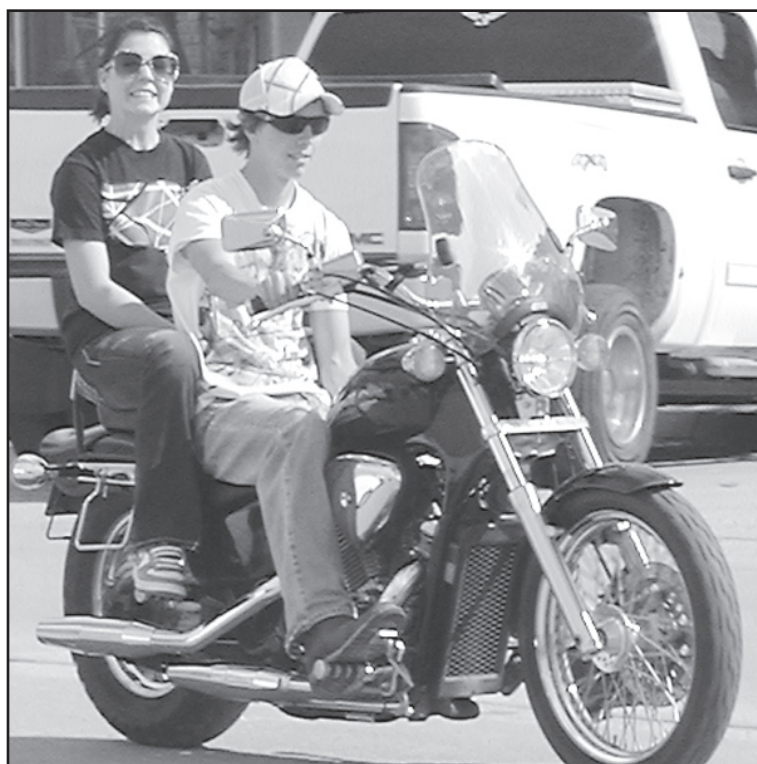
Spring weather is unsettled

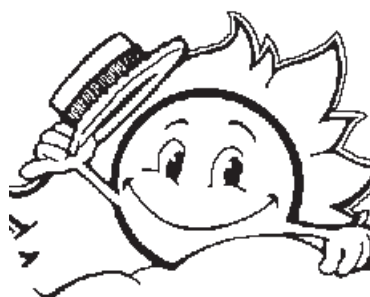
