Recycling is popular

karen.k@nwkansas.com Cheyenne County residents are doing well at recycling was the words heard at the Monday, March 15, county commissioners' meeting.

Roger Jensen, county representative to the Northwest Kansas Regional Recycling Board, reported that in 2009, the county had brought in 112.9 tons of recyclables which included newspapers, cardboard, office, junk, chipboard, books, magazines, plastic, aluminum cans, tin cans and glass. They had also used the opportunity and brought in ewaste, totaling 122.2 tons.

The Northwest Kansas Regional Recycling Service includes eight recycled 112.9 tons.


