RESOLUTION 10-04

A RESOLUTION OF DECLARATION OF MINIMUM MAINTENANCE ROADS WITHIN THE COUNTY OF CHEYENNE. STATE OF KANSAS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is the governing body of Cheyenne County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has statutory authority pursuant to the provision of K.S.A. 68-5,102, and are of the opinion that certain roads in Cheyenne County should be declared minimum maintenance roads; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed certain roads in all districts of the county and have determined that these roads should be posted as "Minimum Maintenance, travel at your own risk. '

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Cheyenne County, Kansas that the following road within Cheyenne County, Kansas, be posted as a minimal maintenance road:

BEGINNING at the northwest corner of Section 36, Township 3 South, Range 42 West, thence three miles south, then one mile east ending at the northeast corner of Section13, Township 4 South, Range 42 West.

BEGINNING at the northwest corner of the southwest guarter of Section 7, Township 4 South, Range 42 West, thence running south for almost two miles and ending at the intersection of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 19, Township 4 South, Range 42 West.

BEGINNING at the northwest corner of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 42 West, thence going east approximately 4,000 feet, thence southeast 1,425 feet ending at Road 4 in the northeast quarter of same said section.
