## Tracksters compete at Wichita

Seniors Matt Raile, Trent Raile and Alex Long and junior Garrett Figgins attended the 2A State track meet in Wichita on May 28 and 29. They qualified to participate in the state meet by placing in the top four at the WaKeeney Regionals on Friday, May 21.

Olpe won the boys division with a total of 47 points while Bennington placed second with 39 points. Oakley, a member of the Northwest Kansas League, placed third with 31.5 points.

Results of the Indian attempts are as follows:

Matt was entered in three events, the 100-meter dash, the 200-meter dash and the long jump. He finished the 100-meter dash in a time of 11.66 for 14th place, the 200-meter dash with a time of 23.54 for 10th place and he did not place in the long jump but his distance was 19-7.

In the javelin, Alex placed 13th in the prelims with a distance of 144 feet.

Trent finished 12th in the prelims in the 400-meter dash. He had a time of 53.38.

Garrett had a time of 16.45 in the prelims of the 110-meter hurdles for a 10th place and a
