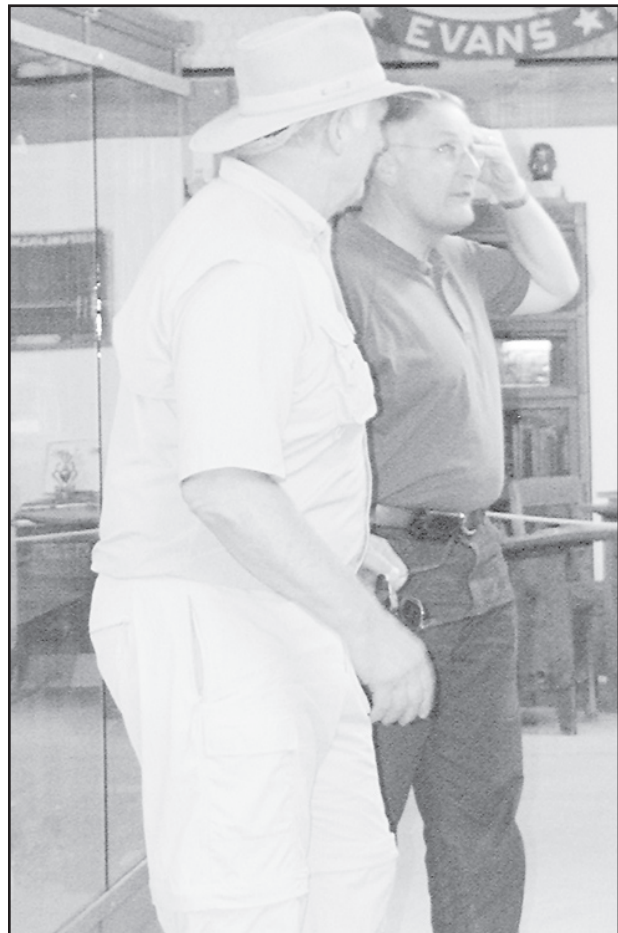




# Over 300 alumni meet for weekend
