# Memorial to be held for serviceman on anniversary

The Harrison Family will gather at the St Francis Cemetery on Saturday, July 24, at 10:30 a.m. to honor Robert Francis Harrison on the 40th anniversary of his death.

Francis was a true patriot, very proud to be an American and to have served his country. He gave all his family pride in this country and service to all. The family has regretted the fact that no military honors were accorded him at his funeral 40 years ago. They have arranged this tribute with a Marine Honor Guard to rectify the oversight.

The Harrison family welcomes friends, family, and neighbors to attend this memorial service. Following the service a private lunch will be served at the St Francis Senior Center from noon to 1:30. Everyone is welcome to meet at the open house from 1:30 to 4 p.m. also at the Senior Center Refreshments will be served; there will be special music and displays from the history of the family. Everyone is welcome to come and share

their memories.

Francis was born in Cheyenne County on Oct. 17, 1916, to Robert L and Bertha Harrison. Francis had an older brother, Benjamin who died in 1935 and two younger sisters, Betty Ann Harrison (Marion Miller) and Mary Harrison (Norman Dorsch). They grew up on the family farm at South Fork, 15 miles east of St Francis on the "River Road."

Francis enlisted in the Marine Corps in 1942 and was sent to the South Pacific during World War II. He fought on Guadalcanal, Tarawa and Saipan and was badly wounded in the battle there.

Returning to Kansas in the fall of 1944, he married his fiancée, Eula Kirkman, on Oct. 2, 1944. They spent time in South Carolina before he was sent to serve out the remainder of his enlistment as a Military Police (MP) in Guam where he guarded Japanese prisoners of war (POW's).

The Harrisons had three daughters, Nancy, Susan and Linda and in 1962 moved to Limon, Colo., where they were partners in the new bowling alley there. Francis was in Lamar for a family gathering to celebrate the baptism of grandson, Jon David Widlund when he died on July 26, 1970.
