Francis had an older brother, Benjamin who died in 1935 and two younger sisters, Betty Ann Harrison (Marion Miller) and Mary Harrison (Norman Dorsch). They grew up on the family farm at South Fork, 15 miles east of St Francis on the "River Road."
