Area man injured in roll over accident

Roger Samler, 57, St. Francis, was in a one-vehicle accident early Saturday morning. Sheriff Craig Van Allen said the accident happened at around 1:30 a.m. on Roads 4 and Z but law officers and the ambulance were not called until later. The sheriff was told that Samler, driving a jeep, swerved

to avoid hitting a deer and rolled into a field. He was not wearing a seat belt, was ejected and the jeep rolled on him.

He was taken to the Benkelman Hospital by ambulance and later flown out to a hospital in Loveland, Colo.

Police Report

In the month of July, St. Francis City Police officers have responded to three accidents, one arrest, two burglaries, and two cases of criminal assault.
