These owners have been warned numerous times and one had some progress but the council decided to proceed with the court hearings.

Felzien Street was elevated, Mr. Landenberger said, and the drainage is much improved. Felzien Street runs north and south between Pizza Hut and Bill Wilson

Mr. Landenberger suggested the council consider a new water system/water tower. There were some issues, said Mr. Landenberger, during the wind storm and power outages. Mr. Landenberger said the system is dated, and during power outages may have problems with water delivery.

Other business

In other business:

- A small business incentive was given to Computer Solutions owned by Galen and Judy Lambert at 109 N. Quincy.

- A landscape license was approved for Troy Porter.

- A tree trimming license was postponed for Delbert Rice, as insurance limits need to be increased.

- The council agreed to let the county have a secure, dedicated phone line for the 911 call center in the St. Francis Emergency Building. If there is an emergency, the county has a portable unit for 911 calls and the unit could be set up in the emergency manager's office in the building.

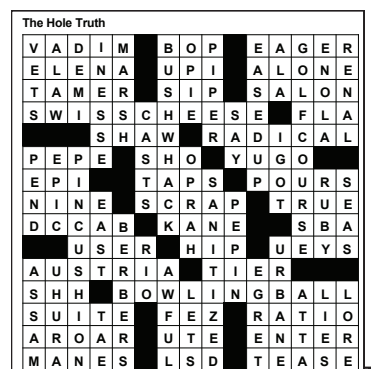
The next meeting of the city council is set for 7:30 p.m. on Monday at city hall.
