After spending the night in Denver, they flew to Seattle on June 30, where the four of them met up with 10 other family members from four cities across the country.

While in Seattle, they went to the Space Needle and enjoyed beautiful views of the city after riding the elevator to the top. The next morning, they boarded the Norwegian Star cruise ship for an eight-day excursion through British Columbia, Canada and Alaska's Inside Passage. Ports of call were Ketchikan, Juneau, Skagway and Prince

They experienced weather that was mostly sunny and in the 60s and 70s - quite unusual for Southeast Alaska in August. Highlights included a catamaran boat tour of Misty Fjords National Monument; a 1,800-foot tram ride up to Mt. Roberts in Juneau, which offered Francis, KS 67756.

panoramic views of the city, harbor and surrounding mountains; sailing into Tracy Arm and up to Sawyer Glacier; and a train ride out of Skagway on an historic narrow gauge railroad built in 1898. Both orca and humpback whales were sighted during the trip.

A special dinner celebration was held on the ship one evening to honor not only the Zweygardt's 60th anniversary, but also daughter and son-in-law Cathy and Dan Gleason's 30th anniversary, and grandson, Jeremy Steinbeck, and his wife Kira's fifth anniversary.
