

# Former resident receives award

Former resident, Stan Faulkender, was recently honored at the 40th annual Kansas Wrestling Coaches Association Hall of Fame and awards banquet on Saturday, Oct. 30, in Salina. Mr. Faulkender is a long time Ellis High School teacher and coach.

Mr. Faulkender's wrestling career began in Northwest Kansas as it has for so many influential Kansas wrestlers and coaches before and since. From 1965 to 1968, he wrestled for the St. Francis Indians winning Kansas state championships at 112 pounds in 1966 and 127 pounds in 1967.

His two individual championships helped the Indians capture Kansas State Team championships those same two seasons.

"St. Francis, the people and their support," he said, "had a lot to do with my success as an athlete, teacher, coach and a man."

From 1970 to 1971 he wrestled at Colby Community College earning All-American status in 1970 with a third place finish at Nationals.

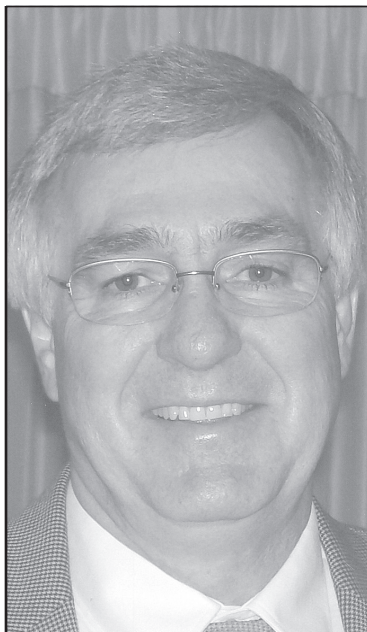
Mr. Faulkender's coaching career was spent successfully leading the Ellis Roadrunners wrestling

team during two stints from 1973 - 1974 to 1976 - 1977; and from 1980 - 1981 to 1991 - 1992. Ellis had 54 state qualifiers, 14 state placers, and two state champions during his tenure.

In 1991 he was recognized with the Sportsmanship Award by the Kansas Wrestling Officials Association. In addition, Coach Faulkender served Ellis High as football coach and activities director for a number of years.

It has been acknowledged that Coach Faulkender's influences as a fine wrestling ambassador and as a great role model are perhaps his best traits. According to Coach, his success at Ellis is rooted, "... in the patience of my family, the great kids I coached, and the support of the community all of which was none of my doing."

Coach humbly gives thanks and deep appreciation to his wife Sherri, his daughters Dallas and Molly, and "... the entire town of Ellis." Appropriately, Coach Faulkender serves as a pastor and credits "... the patience and discipline of wrestling and coaching wrestling ..." for preparing him for this heavy task. He hopes that "... these same traits have been

instilled in the young men whom I have coached."

Coach offers these regards and the following scripture verse: "If there is any praise, honor, or glory I give it all to Jesus." Ephesians 6:12; "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places."

Coach Faulkender was joined in Salina by his wife Sherri, daughter Dallas, son-in-law Brian Bieker, granddaughters Lexi and Macy, daughter Molly, son-in-law Scott Bieker, and grandchildren Adrienne and Cole. Other family members attending were Stan's brother Roger Faulkender and nephew Troy Faulkender. Also joining the coach were Casey Dinkel, Brandon Armbruster, Kevin Weber and Gary Seibel, all current wrestling coaches and former wrestlers of Coach Faulkender. Corey Burton, Ellis High School principal and former wrestler and coach, was also in attendance.

Coach Faulkender's bio and picture can now be found on the KWCA Hall of Fame Wall located at Gross Memorial Coliseum on the campus of Fort Hays State University.

Stan is the son of the late Fizz and Grace Faulkender.
