Service receives \$2,500

Lori Janicke of Bird City, has been selected as a winner in America's Farmers Grow Communities program, which gives farmers the opportunity to win \$2,500 for their favorite local nonprofit organizations. The awards are available

through Monsanto Fund. Mrs. Janicke designated the Cheyenne County Emergency Medical Service, located in St. Francis, to receive the award. The award was presented to director, Janelle Bowers, on Wednesday, Nov. 17, with Monsanto representative, Kurt Wilson, Colby. Others present were emergency medical technicians, Wade Krien, Erika Zimbelman, Reid Raile, Ed Marin and Johnny Miller.

In its initial year, the America's Farmers Grow Communities program has provided nearly 500 farmers in 10 states with \$2,500 awards to direct to their favorite nonprofit organization. On Aug. 31, the program expanded nationwide to more than 1,200 counties in 38 states.
