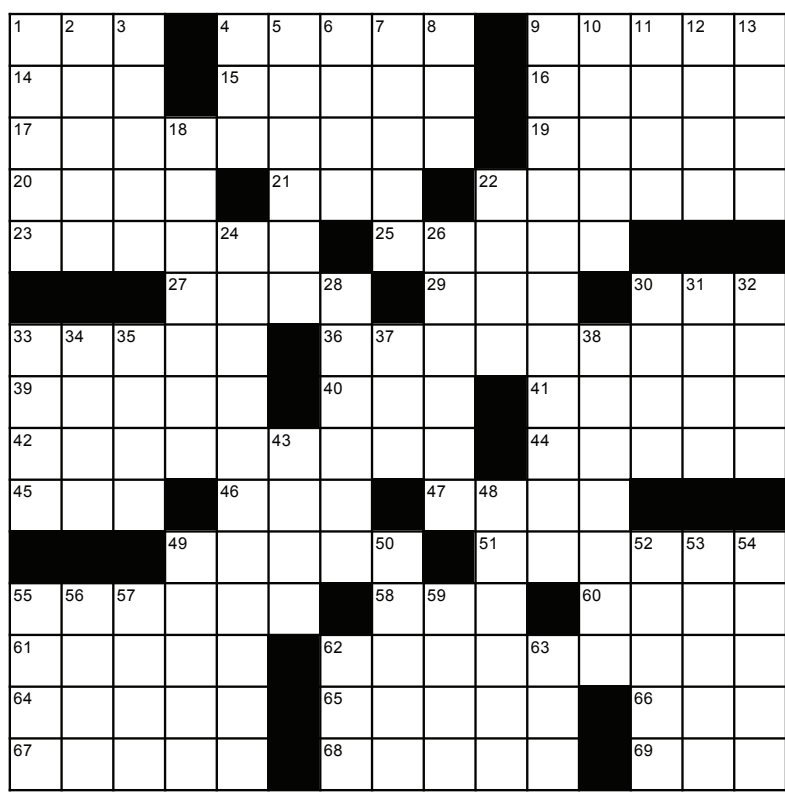

The Office of Cheyenne County Emergency Management along with E-Fm Consulting, LLC will be conducting the final public meeting for discussion and input on the Cheyenne County Hazard Mitigation Plan. The County and incorporated areas are developing Local Hazard Mitigation Plans per the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and guidance of the Kansas Division of Emergency Management.
