"For our first meet I thought the girls did alright," Coach Nathan Smith said. "There were some surprises like Aly Schlepp ran a great 800-meter."

St Francis athletes in the first eight positions include Lexi Hilt, Kaitlin Figgins, Mikaela Grace, Shelby Cassaw, Aly Schlepp and Ally Northrup on the girl's team and Adam Guthmiller, Isaac Schiltz, Cody Killingsworth, Mason Schiltz, Dylan Wolaver, Derek Queen, Lane Hoffman, Logan Lampe, Casey Keller,

Garrett Figgins, Ty Zwegygart and Tyler Raby on the men's team.

Isaac Schiltz was the lone first place finisher for the Indians. He was first in the high jump with a leap of 5-10. Second place finishers included Kaitlin Figgins in the discus with 97-10, Aly Schlepp in the 800-meter run with 2:43.30, I. 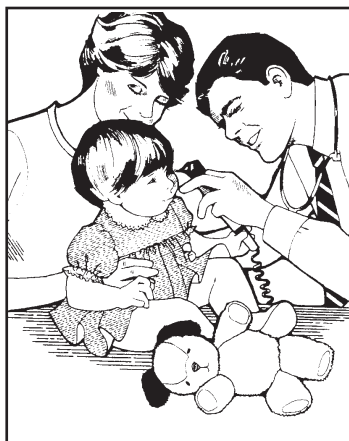
