Indian tracksters compete in Colby April 11

Oakley won the girls division of the Triplains Invitational on Tuesday, April 11, with 105.5 points while Wallace County took the boys division with 68 points.

The Lady Indians tied for fourth with 46 points. It was a three-way tie with Greeley County and Weskan.

The Indians collected 54 points for fifth.

Kaitlin Figgins was a first place finisher in the discus with

a throw of 106-4. Saintry had two second place finishers in the girls division: Aly Schlepp had a time of 2:45.85 in the 800-meter run and Sarah Trembly was second in the discus with a throw of 92-5.00.

Two Indians placed first in the boys division. Garrett Figgins was first in both the 300-meter hurdles and the 110-meter high hurdles. In the 110, he ran a time of 16.44 while he was clocked at 44.47 in the 300-meter hurdles.

Also placing first was Mason Schiltz in the pole vault with

a leap of 12-0. Isaac Schiltz was 11-0 in the pole vault for a second place finish.

Following the Easter break, the Indians will be hosting the St. Francis Invitational on Tuesday, April 26.

The Oakley Invitational was canceled on Friday, April 15, due to snow and icy roads. The St. Francis school were closed as were area roads.

Garrett Figgins, Isaac Schiltz and Mason Schiltz were among those athletes listed in the Area Track and Field Honor Roll published in the *Salina Journal* on Friday, April 15. The *Journal* listed the top 10 tracksters in each event from the list coaches had reported to the paper.

Figgins was listed in the eighth position in the 110-meter hurdles with a time of 16.44 and in the 10th position in the 300-meter hurdles with a time of 44.47. The top time listed in the 110-meter hurdles was 15.57 and the top time in the 300-meter hurdles was 42.03.

Isaac Schiltz made the high jump list with leap of 6-0. He was one of six trackers on the list with 6-0. In first place was a jump of 6-5.

Mason Schiltz was in the fifth position in the pole vault with a height of 12-0. The number one pole vaulter was at 13-6.

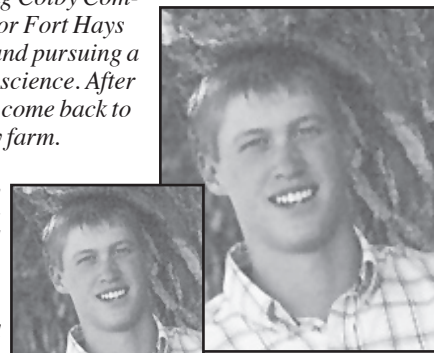
Congratulate Your Graduate
