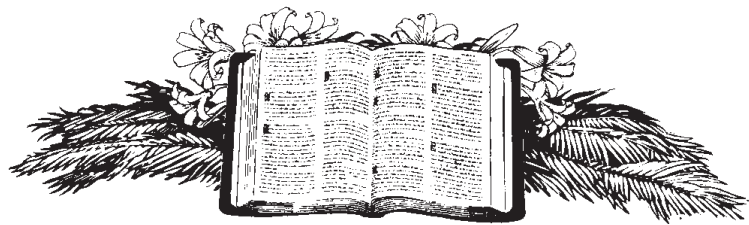

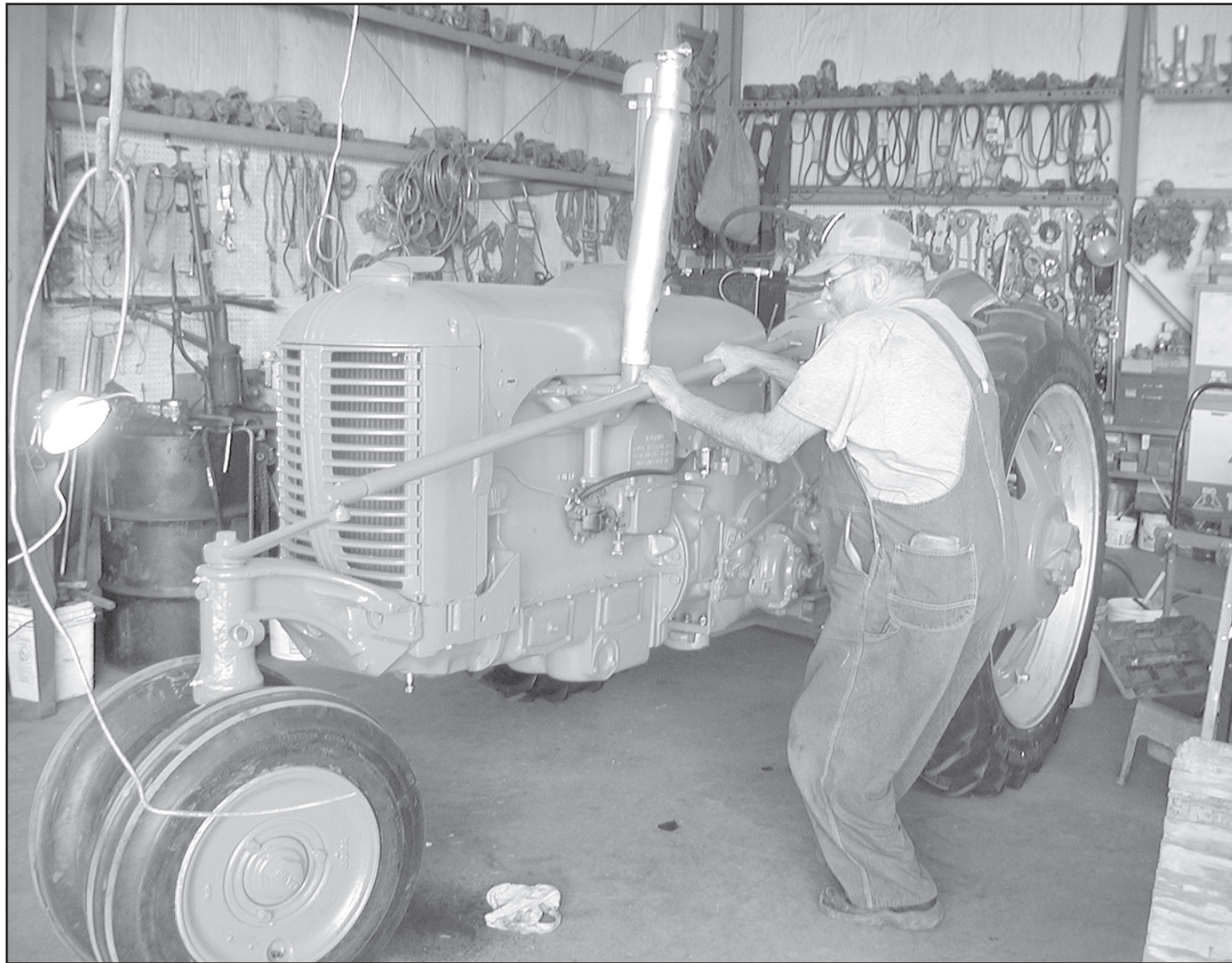
THE STATE OF KANSAS TO ALL PERSONS CONCERNED:

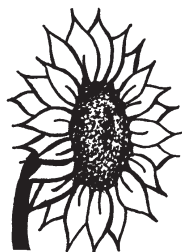
